DEDICATION CEREMONY FOR OBEDIENCE SMITH HISTORICAL MARKER

A historical marker in honor of Obedience Smith is being installed at Lanier Middle School. In 1838, Obedience Smith (1771-1847) was the recipient of a 5.26 square mile land grant from the Republic of Texas. The land extended from downtown Houston at Lamar and Louisiana, west to River Oaks, and south to Rice University. The Winlow Civic Club is holding a dedication ceremony for the historical marker on Saturday, September 10, at 10:00 AM at Lanier.
