 able to get an idea of the flow of the day. Students will receive their
 actual schedule during the technology distribution.
- We will providing students with a virtual instruction supply kit.
 Students will receive school supplies to make sure they are ready for success on the fist day of school. Students will receive the supply packs during technology distribution days.

Important Reminders

Attendance. Attendance will be taken everyday in every class. We strongly encourage all students to participate in live instruction daily. If students are unable to participate in the live instruction on any day, they can log into the HUB and complete assignments to be counted present for the day prior to 11:59.

Grades. Students will receive 2 grades per week per class. Please make sure that your scholar is completing all required assignments in the HUB daily. You will be able to track your students progress in PowerSchools. We will provide additional information on how to use the new parent portal soon.

Expectations. Students are expected to interact appropriately in the virtual environment the same as in person. Appropriate dress, language and technology usage are non-negotiable. We need all students engaged in the learning daily with a ready-to-work attitude. We need your support to ensure we are able to meet the needs of all students with minimal distractions and disruptions. As I share with the students daily in person, "teachers came to teach and students came to learn, every day is a fine day for learning".
