FAMILY NEEDS

STUDENT MEDICATION

2. We will provide a drive-up and pick-up method for parents who need to pick up student medication from the nurse. See schedule below.

ONLINE CURRICULUM

3. The district will be providing online curriculum and lessons via the HUB, along with other digital resources. This can be accessed via cell phone. However, If your child needs technology to access these resources, we will be checking out laptops, chromebooks, and iPads on a needed basis. Parent support can be found at HISD@Home

A. During the week of March 23, students should simply become familiar logging in, accessing the HUB, and online resources.

B. Teachers will be reaching out to their classes next week and will be creating online platforms for teacher/student communication

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

4. Students will also be able to pick up personal belongings if any were left in lockers. We will be practicing social distancing by only allowing 10 or less students on campus at a time to get their belongings. Gloves and hand sanitizer will also be given to students to use while accessing lockers. Please communicate to your child that this is not a time for socializing with friends and will be given a specific timeframe to gather belongings.

PICK-UP METHOD & PROCEDURES

We will use a drive up method. **NOTE: Parents and students should remain in their vehicles until an administrator is able to assist.**

Students must be with a parent/adult. Families who are walking will also follow the instructions below. An administrator will assist with walkers.

If your child only needs to get belongings out of their locker...

A. Drive up on LAMONTE. We will use the Side gate behind the 6th gr building.

If you need to pick up medication, technology, or need a paper copy of the online lessons...

B. Drive up in the main entrance.
