- Face-to-face instruction begins on October 19,2020
- Parents may opt-in or opt-out of virtual learning at the start of each six-week grading period.

Returning Face-to-Face

- Preliminary Numbers:

Total	389	583	61	1033

Total number of students returning face-to-face is between 389-450.

Updates

- Beginning October 19, 2020, Hogg teachers will teach students **virtually and face-to-face simultaneously**.
 - We have chosen this model for the following reasons:
 - It is more likely that students will maintain their current schedules and continue to receive instruction from their current teachers.
 - Allow for students to continue virtual instruction if the building needs to close.
 - Continue to implement IB requirement and guidelines.
 - Allow us to continue to serve our community with their specific needs
 - Social Emotional Support
 - Special Education Services
 - Tier II & Tier III Interventions

Hogg's Reopening Plan

- Campus Wellness Committee
 - Nurse, Admin, Admin Assistants, Counselor, Wraparound, & CIS
- Daily screening before entering the building
 - Temperature checks and short questionnaire
- Face masks will be required and provided by the district for all staff and students
 - Must cover your mouth and nose
- Antibacterial wipes and gloves in each classroom, provided weekly
- Sanitation dispensers have been installed in each classroom

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Hogg's Reopening Plan

- Isolation room for students who exhibit Covid19 symptoms
- Hourly restroom cleaning/ cleaning throughout the day in high-touch areas
- Procedures will be in place for staff & students if a COVID-19 case is confirmed on campus. (confidentiality of identified person)
- Closure of campus is determined on a case by case basis by HISD Health and Medical Services & Facilities Maintenance and Operations
- Communication will be sent out by the **Health and Medical Director** to staff, students, and parents.

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Hogg's Reopening Plan

- Implement safe campus procedures for arrival, dismissal, and class transitions.
 - Staggered class transitions
 - One-way stairs
 - Staff stationed in the hallway to monitor transitions and restrooms
- Classrooms reconfigured for social distancing (average 14 to 1)
 - Classroom Safety Kit: Antibacterial wipes, masks and gloves provided weekly
- Breakfast & Lunch will be in the classroom
- Sanitation dispensers in each classroom and office

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Hogg's Reopening Plan

- Teachers will wipe down desks and door handles between each class.
- Students will not be able to share supplies, books, food, or masks.
- Water fountains are off limits. We encourage all students to bring a water bottle from home.
- Students will have assigned seats in each classroom.
- Alternate spaces may be used for classrooms.

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Face-to-Face Instruction

- Building Opens at 8:00 am
 - Classes: 8:30 am - 4:00 pm
- Uniforms are not required
- Classrooms reconfigured for social distancing (average 14 to 1)
- Plexiglass shield for teacher
- Certified Teacher in every classroom
- Students bring their own device to and from school

 - Design, The Arts, Physical Education, Language Acquisition
