- **School Improvement Plan (SIP)**
 - B- → B+last year
 - Changing student demographics
 - Over 50 different Houston communities present on our campus
 - Application numbers rising each year
 - Entering fifth year with BCM partnership
 - 2020-2021 school year goals:
 - at least 90% of students will **grow** to meet their STAAR progress measure on the Reading/Writing, Math, Social Studies assessments → response: double block math, additional reading interventionist, part-time interventionist, Literacy support for ELA teachers; *higher need for social studies than science therefore social studies chosen*
 - ELL students meeting standards will increase by 10% → *passing STAAR reading will address this goal*
 - Number of out of school suspensions will decrease by 25% → response: SEL instruction, restorative circles, monthly grade level assemblies, school wide initiatives
 - 98% attendance based on the summer PEIMS submission → increased by 3%; response: monitoring attendance,

- Students returning to campus for second six weeks:
 - 6th grade: 50
 - 7th grade: 58
 - 8th grade: 50
- Students staying virtual for second 6 weeks:
 - 6th grade: 73
 - 7th grade: 94
 - 8th grade: 96
- Staff to receive self-screening app approximately one week before return to campus: **Axiom Medical's Checkin2work** app (3 questions)
- El Centro: offering face masks for students that they can deliver, Eastwood location (Telephone & Polk) offering free COVID-19 testing for students, families, and teachers, to send an email with further information
