#### \*KEY DEFINITIONS:

Budget: A spending plan. A plan that balances money coming in (income) with money going out (expenses).

<u>Savings</u>: The process of setting income aside for future spending. Saving provides ready cash for emergencies and short-term goals, and funds for investing.

<u>Financial Literacy</u>: The ability to use knowledge and skills to manage one's financial resources effectively for *lifetime financial security.*

## Essay Contest Guidelines Deadline: Wednesday, March 21, 2012

#### CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be a student in grades 6-12 in their school.
- Have knowledge of money management skills (decision-making related to spending and saving, investing, use of credit, etc.) appropriate for their age and grade level.
- Demonstrate how they practice good money management skills in their daily lives.
- Live in the Greater Houston area.

#### TO APPLY:

- Students must be recommended by a teacher using the attached form. (Note: Official school sponsorship is not required.)
- Student must have parent or guardian permission to apply and participate.
- Student must write an essay (500 words or less) on the assigned topic.
- Essays should be typed on plain white paper, double-spaced. The Houston Money Week Essay Contest Application should be attached to the essay pages.
- The essay must be the work of the student submitting the essay.
- The application form must be signed by the teacher and a parent/guardian.
- No teacher may sign more than five recommendations.
