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

### WHAT IS AN M/WBE?

An M/WBE is a business enterprise that is at least 51 percent owned, operated, managed, and controlled by one or more members of the following socially or economically disadvantaged groups:

- African Americans
- Hispanic Americans
- Asian/Pacific Island Americans
- Native American Indians (American Indians, Eskimos, Aleuts, and native Hawaijans)
- · Asian Indian Americans · Women

The Houston Independent School District established the Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (M/WBE) Program in 1988 to advocate fair and equitable opportunities for the participation of M/WBE firms, in the areas of procurement, construction, and professional services.

### WHAT IS THE HISD SUPPLIER DIVERSITY PROGRAM?

The HISD Supplier Diversity Program works to assist with securing M/WBE participation in various district projects by:

- Identifying project needs
- Organizing networking opportunities
- Providing technical assistance for bid documents
- Monitoring M/WBE payments
- Creating M/WBE participation reports

- Advocate fair and equitable opportunities for the participation of M/WBE firms
- To increase and utilize M/WBE firms in as many HISD projects as possible
- To work with M/WBE suppliers and HISD departments to create active business partnerships
