There are many ways schools can show appreciation to their school-based partners. Remember to be specific, make it personal, and be authentic. Here are some examples:

- Thank you letters, certificates of appreciation or recognition;
- Student-generated cards for various holidays, i.e. Valentines' Day;
- Recognition and awards presentations on the campus;
- Partner appreciation breakfast or luncheon, appreciation programs with student talent;
- Feature the partners' name on the school marquee;
- Presentation of school art;
- Mememtos from partnership activities on the campus i.e. paint brushed in shadow box;
- Submit stories to the HISD Communications department for the district's portal and newsletters; and
- Nominate partners for awards such as the HISD Volunteers in Public Schools awards, Greater Houston Service awards, sponsored by VolunteerHouston; Comcast Hispanic Hero Awards;
- Give a shout out on social media. Many businesses and corporations relish getting a Yelp review. Create a profile and give your community organization or business a recognition review on Yelp! HISD Twitter and Facebook are other options.
