The Houston Independent School District recognizes that high quality human capital is critical to the achievement of our students. Retaining its top performers and coaching them into the roles best suited to their skills is the responsibility of any competitive employer and HISD intends to accomplish this, in part, through the Human Capital Fellowship.

During their second year in HISD, Teach For America corps members can apply to the fellowship. Participation begins the summer prior to the third year with the district and lasts for the duration of the school year.

Fellows have the opportunity to:

- Attend a 5-day leadership institute at the Harvard Graduate School of Education
- Collaborate with an assigned mentor who holds a leadership position within the district
- Experience unique professional development opportunities aligned with personal goals
