**Q: Do you have a breakdown of the different primary languages spoken by EL students?**

A: Yes, we do. There are over 95 languages spoken by ELs in HISD. The largest language groups include Spanish, Amharic, Arabic, Cantonese, Mandarin, Farsi, French, Hindi, Japanese, Nepali, Pashto, Russian, Swahili, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu, and Vietnamese.

**Q: Who at the school campus oversees Migrant Educational Programs?**

**Q: Are Migrant Education Programs and English Learner (ESSA Requirements) separate? Overlap?**

A: Yes, they are separate federal programs. In some cases, students can be identified as an English Learner and migrant. In other circumstances, students may be identified as migrant only. Not all migrant students are English Learners.
