

## Federal Report Cards – 2021 – 2022

The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), requires each State education agency to prepare and publish an annual report card with state-, local education agency (LEA)- and campus-level data. The Federal Report Card data is for the previous school year (2021 – 2022) and is now available on the TEA website.

Each district that receives Title I, Part A funding is responsible for disseminating the state-, LEA- and campus-level report cards to 1) all LEA campuses, 2) parents of all enrolled students, and 3) the general public via widely available public means, such as posting on the Internet, distribution to the media, or distribution through public agencies. As required by ESSA, principals of all HISD schools (Title I and non-Title I) must inform parents of all enrolled students that the Federal Report Card information is available for school year 2021-2022.

How the Federal Report Card is disseminated is determined by the campus. At a minimum, campuses are required to publicize parent notification letters in English, Spanish and Vietnamese (based on the campus language needs) and post the information on the campus website. Additionally, HISD and campuses are required to provide links to all of the Federal Report Cards - TEA, HISD and the campus-specific reports. The deadline for campuses to disseminate and post their campus report card is **Friday, February 24, 2023**.
