1. All coordinators must attend the beginning of the year Informational Meeting.
2. Virtual informational meeting for coordinators, coaches, and parents on the day registration opens for all invitational meets. Informational will review all contest rules and resources.
3. Invitational Meet registration is open for 2 weeks (14 calendar days) on [www.speechwire.com](http://www.speechwire.com)
  - Registration cannot be extended beyond the deadline. *See the Quick Reference for dates.*

4. Contestants are not allowed to compete a grade level down.
