Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) is the federal accountability component of the No Child Left Behind Act. Schools are required to meet annual targets in reading and mathematics performance and participation and graduation rate for high schools/attendance rate for elementary and middle schools. The Texas Education Agency released the final ratings for the 2008 AYP on December 18.

According to the 2008 final AYP results, HISD received a district rating of Missed AYP due to the Graduation Rate. The following table summarizes the number of schools rated Meets AYP or Missed AYP in the last three years. The 2006, 2007, and 2008 counts are final AYP results.

Introduction

No Child Left Behind Act of 2001

The *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB)* is a landmark education reform bill designed to improve student achievement and change the culture of America's schools. With passage of NCLB on January 8, 2002, Congress re-authorized, amended, and renamed the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA)*—the principal federal law affecting education from kindergarten through high school. The resulting law represents a sweeping overhaul of federal efforts to support elementary and secondary education in the United States. NCLB is built on four common-sense pillars: accountability for results; an emphasis on using proven, scientifically-based research; expanded parental options; and expanded local control and flexibility.

Accountability is a key component of the NCLB. Each state is required to develop and implement a statewide accountability system that is effective in ensuring that all districts and schools make adequate yearly progress, and in holding accountable those that do not. Schools that do not make adequate yearly progress will be identified for increasingly rigorous sanctions designed to bring about meaningful change in instruction and performance. Further, students in low-performing schools will have the option to transfer to other public schools or to obtain supplemental educational services. Finally, the law mandates the fundamental restructuring of any school that fails to improve over an extended period of time.

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)

Under NCLB, states are required to establish a definition of adequate yearly progress that each district and school is expected to meet. Annual targets are set by the state to measure progress of schools and districts toward the goal that all students-including low-income students, students from major racial and ethnic groups, students with disabilities, and students with limited English proficiency-reach 100 percent proficiency in reading and math by 2013–2014. In addition to academic performance, schools must test at least 95 percent of their students in each of the above student groups in reading and math and meet an approved target on one other non-academic measure. In Texas, the non-academic indicator is the four-year longitudinal graduation rate for high schools and the attendance rate for elementary and middle schools. All HISD schools with the exception of new campuses, Disciplinary Alternative Education Program campuses, and early childhood centers are included in the AYP evaluation of district and school performance. The AYP system of accountability is in addition to the Texas Education Agency's system of accountability.

The three AYP indicators are reading/english language arts, mathematics, and high school graduation rate/elementary and middle school attendance rate. Both the reading/English language arts and mathematics indicators have two components: student performance and participation. The criteria must be achieved on both components for the indicator to be considered met. **Table 1** shows the key facets of AYP under the NCLB Act for Texas districts and schools, 2007–2008.

Major Assumptions of AYP

All Schools

Under NCLB, states are required to establish a single definition of adequate yearly progress that applies to all districts and schools, including Title I and non-Title I schools, alternative education campuses, and open-enrollment charter schools. The only schools not rated are new campuses during their first year of operation, Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) campuses, and early childhood centers.

All Students

All students must be tested and the results must be included in AYP calculations. For Texas, this means that performance calculations include the results for students in grades 3–8 and 10 from the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS); the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills-Alternative (TAKS-Alt); Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills-Accommodated (TAKS (Accommodated)), and the Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills-Modified (TAKS-M), for students receiving special education services; and the Linguistically Accommodated Test (LAT) mathematics and reading exam for Limited English Proficient (LEP) students exempted from the TAKS.

Performance Standards

Annual targets are set by the state to measure progress of schools and districts toward the NCLB requirement that all students reach 100 percent proficiency in reading and math by 2013–2014. **Table 2** presents the annual targets for Texas schools and districts.

Participation Standards

In addition to performance standards in reading and math, districts and campuses must meet test participation standards of 95 percent in both subjects. The participation rates are calculated as the number of students tested on any of the eligible tests (TAKS, TELPAS (First year Reading only), TAKS-Alt, TAKS-M, TAKS (Accommodated) and LAT) divided by an unduplicated count of answer documents submitted for these tests (enrollment). Participants also include students who were tested but the test answer document was not scored for other reasons. For 2008, students tested on a locally developed alternative assessment (LDAA) are counted as non-participants.

Student Groups

All students and each student group (African American, Hispanic, White, Economically Disadvantaged, Special Education, and LEP) must meet the same performance and participation standards in reading and in math. Minimum size requirements determine whether or not the student group is evaluated.

Other Measures

NCLB requires that high schools must meet a graduation rate standard set by the state and an additional measure for elementary and middle schools, which, in Texas, is the attendance rate. The graduation rate is calculated as the number of graduates after four years divided by the total number of students in the ninth-grade cohort from four years earlier (plus transfers in, minus transfers out).

The attendance rate is calculated at the school level for all students in grades 1–8, as the total number of days students were present divided by the total number of days students were in membership.

The Federal Cap

The Federal Cap refers to the limit set on the number of proficient assessment results from alternate assessments. Alternate assessments based on modified academic achievement standards will be based on a 2% cap, and alternate assessments for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities are subject to a 1% cap. For Texas, the alternate assessments with modified achievement standards are the TAKS-Modified (TAKS-M). The TAKS-Alternate (TAKS-Alt) assessments are for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities.

The overall limit on student passing results from both TAKS-M and TAKS-Alt must be no more than 3%. The district limit on TAKS-Alt student passing results must not exceed the 1% cap and unfilled slots below the 2% cap may not be added to the 1% cap. If the number of TAKS-Alt students passing results falls below the 1% cap, the unfilled slots may be used by student passing results from TAKS-M. The TAKS-M 2% cap limit is calculated as 2% plus any unused slots from TAKS-Alt.

Students who were tested on the TAKS-Alt or TAKS-M will be counted as testers in the participation calculations, and if they met ARD expectations, they will be counted as proficient in the performance calculations **up to a district cap**. After the cap has been reached, the remainder of the students will be counted as **artificial failures**. The state will determine who is counted towards the cap, initially based on a random assignment of students to meet the 1% cap, then based on a campus priority ranking towards the remaining 2% cap.

1% Cap on TAKS-Alt Student Selection Process:

• TAKS-Alt tested students will be randomly selected.

2% Cap on TAKS-M Student Selection Process:

- TAKS-M tested students will be selected in the order of a previously determined priority campus ranking. This is conducted in a manner to meet the extent needed for the priority campuses to Meet AYP;
- If additional proficient students can be included under the federal cap, students are selected to the extent needed for the district to Meet AYP;
- If additional proficient students can be included under the federal cap, students are selected randomly up to the federal cap limit.

Sanctions

Under NCLB, accountability provisions that formerly applied only to district and campuses receiving Title I, Part A funds now apply to all districts and campuses. Sanctions however, still apply only to districts and campuses receiving Title I funds. If a district or campus that receives Title I, Part A funds does not meet the AYP standard for the same measure for two or more consecutive years, that district or campus is subject to certain Title I School Improvement requirements which increase in severity each year. In order to be released from the sanctions, the district or campus must meet the standards for the measure that caused them to go into School Improvement for two consecutive years, remembering that the performance standards will continue to increase over time. Non-Title 1 schools that do not meet the AYP standard for the same measure for two or more consecutive years are required to revise their School Improvement Plan to address the deficit. The requirements for each stage of the sanctions are described below.

The Title 1 School Improvement Stage 1 requirements are as follows:

- The school must develop/revise a two-year school improvement campus plan.
- The school must notify parents of campus school improvement status.
- The school district must offer school choice, and transportation must be provided.
- The school district must establish a peer review process to provide assistance to the campus.

The Title 1 School Improvement Stage 2 requirements are as follows:

- Stage 1 campus and district improvement activities continue.
- Supplemental Education Services must be offered to eligible students on the campus.

The Title 1 School Improvement Stage 3 requirements are as follows:

- Stage 2 Improvement activities continue.
- The school district must implement <u>one</u> of the following corrective actions:
- Replace the school staff relevant to not meeting AYP,
- Implement curricular and staff development activities,
- Significantly decrease management authority at the campus,
- Appoint an outside expert adviser to the campus,
- Extend the school year or school day of the campus, or
- Restructure the organization of the campus.
- The school district must publish and disseminate information regarding corrective action.

The Title 1 School Improvement Stage 4 requirements are as follows:

- The school district must continue to offer school choice, technical assistance, and supplemental education services to eligible students.
- The school district must prepare a plan and make necessary arrangements to implement <u>one</u> of the following options:

- Reopen the school as a charter school,
- Replace principal and staff,
- Contract with a private management company,
- State takeover, or
- Other major restructuring of campus governance.

The Title 1 School Improvement Stage 5 requirements are as follows:

- The school district must continue to offer school choice, technical assistance, and supplemental education services to eligible students.
- The school district must implement the plan identified in Stage 4 and make necessary arrangements to implement <u>one</u> of the following options:
- Reopen the school as a charter school,
- Replace principal and staff,
- Contract with a private management company,
- State takeover, or
- Other major restructuring of campus governance.

Findings

This report supersedes the Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) Preliminary Results 2007–2008 School Year that was produced in October 2008. This revision reflects the results of appeals submitted to the state regarding the ratings of several schools. Specifically, appeals were submitted on behalf of five campuses. Table 3 lists the schools for which appeals were submitted and granted by TEA.

The state granted four of the five appeals. Unfortunately none of the schools were changed from Missed AYP to Met AYP after appeal. Four schools, Furr, Milby, Sharpstown, and Sterling High Schools will still receive ratings of Missed AYP, although the appeals to remove an indicator were granted. An appeal was submitted for Chavez High School but was denied by TEA.

Tables detailing results for the Houston Independent School District (HISD) are provided below and are organized by district, school level, and region. Also provided is a table of schools that missed AYP along with the indicators and the relevant student groups, which determined each school's 2008 rating.

District-Level Rating

HISD was rated Met AYP for the school years 2003 through 2005. Last year, HISD Missed AYP for the graduation rate, only one school in the district missed AYP due to the application of the Federal cap. In 2008, HISD Missed AYP for Mathematics and the graduation rate. **Table 4** provides a count of the schools that met or missed the AYP standards in the last six years. The results are disaggregated by academic level and presented in **Table 5**.

- In 2008, 272 of HISD's 292 campuses were evaluated under the AYP guidelines. Expressly 93% of HISD schools were held accountable under NCLB guidelines. There was one more school evaluated than in 2007.
- Of the 272 schools that were evaluated in 2008, 222 or 82%, met AYP standards. Of the 272 schools evaluated, 50 or 18%, did not meet the AYP standards.

- Of the 183 elementary schools that were evaluated on AYP, 179 or 98%, met the AYP standards.
- Of the 47 middle schools that were evaluated on AYP, 25 or 53%, met the AYP standards.
- Of the 36 high schools that were evaluated on AYP, 17 or 47%, met the AYP standards.
- A disproportionate number of middle schools missed AYP when compared to the rating at the middle and high school levels. Specifically, while middle schools accounted for 17% of the schools evaluated under AYP, they comprised 44% of HISD schools that missed AYP in 2008.

Results by Region or Office

The results of the AYP system of accountability for campuses were examined by region or office. HISD schools are organized in either one of five regions or in one of two offices. The five regions are geographical: Central, East, North, South, or West. The two offices are based on function, either Special Education or Alternative/Charter. The number and percent of schools that met or missed AYP for each region or office are presented in **Table 6**.

- The number of schools rated in each region varied greatly. The range was from 38 schools in the South Region to 62 schools in the West Region.
- The five regions had at least 81.6% of their schools rated as Met AYP. The Central Region had the highest percentage of schools meeting AYP with 87.5%. The South had the highest percentage of schools missing AYP with 23.7%
- Of the 14 schools served by the Alternative/Charter Office that were evaluated on AYP, 64.3% Met AYP, while 35.7% Missed AYP.
- For the Special Education Office, one school was rated. Community Services Missed AYP in 2008.

Campuses Rated as Missed AYP

Under the first year of the AYP system in 2003, eight HISD Title I schools failed to meet AYP standards. Of these schools, four failed to meet AYP for the same indicator in 2004 and were put under Title I School Improvement Stage I sanctions: Kay On-Going HS, Lee HS, Marshall MS, and Wheatley HS. In 2005, three of these schools, Kay On-Going, Lee, and Marshall failed again to meet AYP for the same indicator and were placed on Title I School Improvement Stage 2 sanctions. Wheatley High School met AYP for the first time in 2005, and remained at Stage 1 sanctions. However, in 2006, it failed to meet AYP and was elevated to Stage 2 sanctions. In 2007, ALTA, Chavez, CLC High, CLC Middle, Sam Houston, Jones, Lee, Sharpstown High, Westbury, Wheatley, and Worthing schools failed again to meet AYP and were placed on Stage 3 sanctions. This year 10 new schools were elevated to Stage 4 sanctions, ALTA, Chavez, CLC High, Sam Houston (Closed), Jones, Lee, Sharpstown High, Westbury, Wheatley and Worthing schools. Two of the schools, ALTA and Sam Houston, were closed after the 2007-2008 school year and will not be reopened (**Table 7**).

Based on the AYP performance of Title I schools in 2008, there were 6 schools elevated to Title I School Improvement Stage 3 sanctions including one school, CLC MS, that met AYP in 2008 but will remain on Stage 3 sanctions for one more year. In addition, three other schools were placed on Title I School Improvement Stage 2 sanctions. Seven new schools were elevated to School Improvement Sanctions Stage 1, they are: Carter Career Center, Kashmere, Madison, Ortiz, Pleasant Hill, Provision, and Williams schools. Pleasant Hill Elementary did not reopen for the 2008-2009 school year.
