SUBJECT: **FINAL 2009 TEA ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM RATINGS**

The Texas Education Agency released their decisions with regards to eleven appeals sent on behalf of twelve district campuses (Ashford is paired with Shadowbriar.), and the final 2009 state accountability system ratings have been determined. Of the eleven appeals, six were accepted and granted. The following table indicates how these results change the district's summary results.



Jones High School was raised from *Academically Unacceptable* to *Academically Acceptable*. Love and Oates elementary schools were changed from *Not Rated: Other* to *Recognized*, and E.O. Smith Education Center was changed from *Not Rated: Other* to *Academically Unacceptable*.

Introduction

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) Accountability System is a method of evaluating school districts and schools with regard to their performance on certain student indicators, and of assigning an accountability rating based on that evaluation. The TEA Accountability System is based on an improvement model in which districts and campuses must meet either an absolute standard or an improvement standard for each accountability measure. The four possible standard classifications for districts and individual schools are Exemplary, Recognized, Academically Acceptable, or Academically Unacceptable.

The student performance indicators used to determine if absolute standards are met consist of current year spring Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS), including TAKS-Accommodated, passing rates and dropout or completion rates from the previous year. These indicators provide 35 possible performance variables that are employed to assess each campus and the district as a whole. The performance of all students and of the student groups of African American, Hispanic, White, and Economically Disadvantaged are employed in the process of assigning accountability ratings. These ratings are based on the lowest performance of any of the 35 possible measures. For schools and districts that exhibit Recognized, Academically Acceptable and Academically Unacceptable performance on any of the yearly standards, it is possible to achieve the next higher level of accountability by meeting the required improvement component of the system. The TEA Accountability System Research Brief, available from the Houston Independent School District Department of Research and Accountability, describes the accountability model for the 2008–2009 school year.

From 1993 to 2002, the state’s accountability system rated schools based on the results from the Texas Assessment of Academic Skills (TAAS) and the annual dropout rate for grades 7–12. In 2004 with the change in the state criterion-referenced test to the TAKS, the TEA accountability system was significantly redesigned. The 2008 TEA Accountability System represents the fifth year of this revised system. **Table 1** presents the key facets of the TEA Accountability System for 2009. For comparison of the previous model to the redesigned model in 2004, see the TEA Accountability Ratings 2003–04 School Year Final Report (HISD, 2004).

Modifications made from the 2008 accountability system to 2009 include the Academically Acceptable passing rates for math increased from 50% to 55%; and the passing rate for science increased from 45% to 50%. In addition, the Commissioner of Education has ruled that the School Leaver Provision will not be extended for the 2009 accountability ratings. Districts or campuses rated as Academically Unacceptable, Academically Acceptable, or Recognized may achieve a higher rating by comparing the “Percent Meeting the TAKS Standard with TPM” (Texas Projection Measure) to the accountability standards. **One other important note, due to the impact of the hurricane that struck Houston back in September 2008, TEA has implemented a Hurricane Ike Provision, which allows for special evaluation of accountability ratings for eligible districts and campuses. Four HISD campuses were not rated due to this provision.**

Findings

The results from the TEA 2009 Accountability Rating System analysis of the Houston Independent School District’s (HISD) indicators are presented. Comparison tables provide a summary of the TEA ratings for HISD schools for 16 years, 1993 through 2002, 2004 through 2009; the 2009 TEA ratings of HISD schools by regions.

Also provided is a table of schools that were rated Academically Unacceptable and the reasons for that rating.

This report supersedes the TEA Accountability Ratings 2008–2009 Report produced in July 2009. This revision reflects the results of appeals submitted to the state regarding the ratings of twelve schools. Specifically, eleven appeals were submitted to TEA for the twelve schools listed in **Table 2**. The appeals submitted for Smith E. O. MS, Jones HS, Love ES, Oates ES, Shadowbriar (and Ashford) ES, and Waltrip HS were granted by TEA.

Tables detailing school-level results are provided in this report. These tables are organized by region and provide both the 2008 and the 2009 TEA ratings together with the ratings that would have been assigned based solely on the campuses' TAKS performance and the additional measure that was used to elevate the rating. A listing of schools not rated for the 2008–2009 school year and five prior years' matrices are included in this report.

District-Level Rating

TEA rated HISD as Academically Acceptable for 2009. The district is rated Academically Acceptable because of the performance of the African American student group on the TAKS science test, and the All Students, African American, and Hispanic student groups on the Completion Rate. **Tables 3** and **4** show the count of district schools by rating categories. As the accountability system was significantly redesigned in 2004, the ratings are shown separately for the two systems.

- In 2002, at the end of the previous TEA Accountability System that was based on TAAS passing rates and dropout rates, HISD had 63 Exemplary schools and 106 Recognized schools.
- When the original TEA Accountability System was first implemented in 1993, HISD had no schools receiving Exemplary status, only four schools rated as Recognized, and 55 rated as Low-Performing. For the first year of the new TEA Accountability System, HISD had 9 Exemplary schools, 69 Recognized schools, and 14 Academically Unacceptable schools. These results indicated that HISD had a much more academically sound baseline under this new system than it did under the original TEA Accountability System.
- From 2008 to 2009, the state raised the acceptable standards on the accountability system. The number of Exemplary schools increased from 38 to 84, and the number of Recognized schools increased from 119 to 121, while the total number of Academically Unacceptable schools decreased from 15 to 12. Forty-seven HISD campuses were rated as Academically Acceptable schools in 2009 under the TEA Standard Accountability System.
- There were 12 alternative schools that were rated in 2009 under the Alternative Education Accountability (AEA) system, and all twelve were rated as AEA Academically Acceptable. One AEA campus was not rated due to the Hurricane Ike Provision.

HISD Regions

- The number of schools rated in each region varied greatly. The range was from 17 schools from the Alternative\Charter Office to 64 from the West Region (see **Table 6**).
- With the exception of the smaller Alternative/Charter Region who had two campuses attain the highest rating, all other regions had at least ten schools attain an Exemplary rating. The North and Central regions had the highest numbers with 22 and 20 schools receiving an Exemplary rating, respectively.
- The East Region had no schools rated as Academically Unacceptable while the South and West Regions had the most schools performing at the Academically Unacceptable level of the standard accountability, with both regions having four schools, respectively.

Exemplary Schools

- As a result of the application of the TEA Standard Accountability System, 84 schools, including 71 elementary schools, five middle schools, and eight high schools were rated Exemplary for the 2008–2009 school year (see **Table 7**).
- Lyons, River Oaks, T.H. Rogers, and West University Elementary Schools, and DeBaKey High School for Health Professions have received the Exemplary rating for at least five consecutive years.
- Bush, Condit, Cornelius, and Kolter Elementary Schools, along with Carnegie Vanguard have received the Exemplary rating for the past four consecutive years.

Academically Unacceptable Schools

- As a result of the application of the TEA Standard Accountability System, 12 schools were rated as Academically Unacceptable for 2009 (see **Table 8**).
- Based on a duplicated count, seven schools were rated Academically Unacceptable because of student group performance on the science TAKS, and six schools were rated Academically Unacceptable due to the completion rate indicator.
- Three schools, Fondren Middle School, Lee, and Worthing high schools were rated as Academically Unacceptable for two consecutive years.
