- * Synchronous learning first 30 minutes of each period is online or in-person instruction with teachers and students in real time (Live teach and recorded during this time). Attendance is recorded for students present.
- * The next 45 minutes is designated for independent work with access to the teacher/classmates through Teams for support and small group instruction. This ensures office hours/support are built into each class period. Work should be turned in by the end of the period or no later than 11:59 pm on the same day. There is a 15 minute closure at the end of each period to check back in with class.
- * Asynchronous Learning can occur anytime during the class period or at other times each day where students can log in and view the lesson.

- Each class period may start with a "warm up" the students can work on at the beginning of the live class period. During the class period, teachers are expected to provide short, live, guided practice that allows students to partner through Teams. Students can partner with each other and the teacher in real time. As students understand the material, they can transition to independent work during the designated class period. Assignments should be submitted by the end of the class period through the HUB. Ultimately, students have until 11:59 pm each day to submit their work. Attendance is gained by participating with the class in-person, virtual in Teams during the class period or by submitting the daily assignment by 11:59 pm.
- * For in-person or face-to-face instruction, we will follow the same schedule as above, which matches our regular bell schedule.
- * Attendance for all students should be recorded by 3:30 pm. Those who have engaged with the lesson during the day and those that have turned work into the HUB are marked as "present" and those who have not engaged with the lesson either live or completing work are marked "absent." Late work after midnight on any given day will not be accepted for attendance purposes (but can still be graded).
