Goals for 2021-2022

- ▶ **Reading**=Lantrip will increase our Reading scores from 28% to 70% in Approaching in our overall Reading rating in the STAAR for grades 3rd through 5th grade. Lantrip will increase from 56% to 70% of students reading ON or ABOVE their appropriate Reading (Guided) levels.
- ▶ **Math**= Lantrip will increase our math STAAR scores from 31% approaches for grades 3-5 to 70% approaches. Lantrip will increase to 70% of our students in Kinder-2nd to meet or exceed the math benchmark.
- ▶ **Science**= Lantrip students will increase our SCIENCE STAAR scores from 30% Approaching to 70% Approaching in the STAAR Assessment for 5th grade students.

Goals Continue for 2021-2022

▶ Special Pops=

- ▶ Lantrip will increase its STAAR Special Education Approaching percentage from 14% (4 out of 29 passed) to 50% in READING and from 7% (2 out of 28) to 50% in MATH and our RDSPD students will be able to identify 30 HFW's by 2nd grade.
- ▶ Lantrip will increase its TELPAS levels for 3rd grade EL's by 80% at “Advanced or Advanced High” levels.

▶ Attendance= Lantrip will increase our student attendance rate from 94% to 98%.

▶ Parent & Community= Lantrip will increase our parent involvement/ volunteer numbers from 2 volunteers to 50 volunteers in the 2020-2021 school year.

▶ Safety= Lantrip will decrease it's bullying reports by 50% from 1 reports to 0 reports in the 2020-2021 school year.

- ▶ We are building independent learners.
- ▶ Allow students to conduct chores around the house. This builds responsibility and membership of your family.
- ▶ Allow students to CARRY their own backpacks and lunch boxes.

- ▶ Have a location for schoolwork to be done, ex. Kitchen table, dining table, with NO TV, NO distractions, etc. Have good lighting.
