T. H. Rogers After-School Enrichment Program Policies and Procedures

REGISTRATION FEE \$25.00. Registration is complete only upon receipt of a signed registration form and at least 1/2 of the payment due. You may submit your payment either by Check or Money Order.

EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN is available to you as a convenience. We are solely dependent on payment of tuition and fees to meet our expenses. First payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due upon registration; Second payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due Monday, October 29, 2018. Please make your payments in a timely manner to avoid the \$25.00 late fee charges.

CLASS CANCELLATION. If your child is enrolled in an Enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued.

NO AFTER CLASS SUPERVISION. Absolutely no supervision is provided after enrichment classes are dismissed. All children must be picked up and signed out promptly when class is dismissed or you will be charged a late pick-up fee of \$2.00 per minute starting at 4:30 p.m. After the 5th late pick-up, your child may be suspended from the program. Parents must sign out their child/children in the cafeteria. T. H. Rogers offers an After Care Program, please go to www.houstonisd.org/rogersms for information.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE. In order to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which to teach Enrichment classes, students must exhibit appropriate behavior. Children enrolled in Enrichment classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct required at T. H. Rogers. Children who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to T. H. Rogers's administrators and/or suspension from the Enrichment Program. Children suspended from the Enrichment program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.

NOTIFICATION. It is important that you notify the Enrichment office in writing or via e-mail when your child will be absent. Please make sure the Enrichment office has all updated information on your child: such as an address change and medical information. Emails should be sent to John Dixon at jdixon@houstonisd.org

Art (K-5)

Instructed by: Monart Drawing Studio

Students will learn the Elements of Shape and how to use them in creating drawings from a variety of realistic, abstract, and expressionistic styles. Lessons will introduce students to inspirations from 2Dimensional graphic material, 3Dimensional objects, the human form, perspective, and proportion. Each class encourages students to perfect their technique through a variety of media while also improving their drawing skills. This class is an introduction to representational drawing geared to the attention span and motor coordination of children.

Cake Decorating (K-8)

Instructed by: Krafty Cake Decorating

In this class young bakers will uncover their skills as they put the icing on their cakes, cupcakes, and other delicious treats. Students will enjoy interacting with peers, while learning how to make and color icing, as well as working with fondant. Young bakers will bring home their treats every week. ***Parents please note ANY food allergies on the Medical Emergency Information section of this registration packet.***

Cooking (1-8)

Instructed by: Chef Ellen

This after school program is all about the joy of cooking. Chef Ellen is dedicated to giving every child the experience of a positive connection to food and empowering them to cook for themselves and their families. Chef Ellen is a private chef and culinary instructor whose love of teaching has targeted a variety of audiences in Houston for over 15 years. Chef Ellen teaches cooking classes to all ages and skill levels. No matter what, it'll always be hands on!

Computer Class (3-8)

Instructed by: Monart School

Prerequisite: Experience with digital illustration and computer animation.

This course will teach 3D digital rendition (similar to sculpting clay on a computer) and introductory game design including two-dimensional characters and playing fields.

Karate/Martial Arts (K-8)

Instructed by: Soo Bak Do Houston Martial Arts School

This is a self-defense class where students will be taught discipline, respect, and self-defense techniques. This class is designed for fun while obtaining a positive learning experience. They will focus on physical and mental development. Some of the topics for this class are: respect, discipline, basic-blocking techniques, and physical fitness; plus games that will teach coordination, balance, flexibility and nutrition.

Mad Science (K-6)**Instructed by: Mad Science of Houston**

Through its innovative concept of ‘Edu-tainment’, Mad Science has been able to spark the imagination and curiosity of children everywhere. Their goal is to provide fun, entertaining and exciting activities that instill a clearer understanding of what science is really all about and how it affects the world around them.

Writing (2-8)**Instructed by: Monart Drawing Studio**

Storybook illustration: This is a creative writing course in which students both write and illustrate their own story. Apart from teaching students how to draw, this class encourages students to use their imagination to create unique stories and tell them in various formats including comic strips, single-panel vignettes, and poems. This class allows students to advance both writing and drawing skills, and is one of our most popular after-school programs.

Robotics (K-5)**Instructed by: American Robotics Academy**

Students will learn how to design, build and test remote controlled miniature robots made from Lego Building blocks, including the specialized pieces: axles, gears, beams, wheels, motors, microcomputers, pneumatics and other parts that will enable the student to safely create animated and exciting mechanical movements and other effects. They will understand how things work through hands-on activities that demonstrate the principles of simple and motorized machines, while learning skills of team-work, problem-solving and creative thinking.

Basketball (K-6)**Instructed by: Coach Lyons/Stafford (T H Rogers)**

This program is open to players of all abilities. Our aim is for players to attend an organized coached session after school in order to be taught the key skills of the game. We incorporate the use of games to teach them how to be successful in areas such as dribbling, passing, shooting and team play.

Soccer (K-5)**Instructed by: Sam’s Soccer Jam**

This class is geared for all levels of soccer experience. We start our classes with warm up activities such as stretching, ball exercises, fun drills, and dribbling. Each session has a soccer topic to learn e.g., first session is dribbling. As the class progresses your child will be introduced to passing the ball, receiving the ball when passed to them, enhancing their shooting skills, improving their foot-eye coordination, learn how to turnaround with the ball. We will also focus on how to improve speed and quick thinking skills by using fun game drills and more.

Art (6-8)**Instructed by: Mrs. Soto (T H Rogers)**

This after school class is a diverse art class for a wide range of artistic students interested in working on their portfolios for high school or for future Art 1 classes. Students will design their own project- with help from the teacher who will facilitate problem solving techniques and develop artistic skill sets on a personal level. In addition, a focus on improving Life Drawing Skills will be present in the class via daily drawing practices and studio sessions.
