2023-2024 Standard of Dress

Shirts/Tops: Shirts must be a polo-style collared Uniform Shirt. Shirts must be worn in such a manner that allows no cleavage, mid-riff, or navel exposed as well as NO tied-up shirts. Blue, gold, or white solid-colored tops are the ONLY acceptable color(s). *If provided a Free Dress Day, all tops must have sleeves. Any writing/pictures on shirts cannot have profanity, lewd comments, weapons, or drugs/gang paraphernalia.



Pants/Shorts/Skirts: All bottoms must fit appropriately at the waist and crotch (no sagging pants). They may not have holes or tears in them. All bottoms must be uniform-styled/cargo-styled and ONLY blue, black, or khaki colored Pants, Skirts, or Shorts are allowed, NO jean material allowed Monday - Thursday, jeans ONLY shall be worn on FRIDAY. Skirts and Shorts must be of appropriate length (to the knee-length or below the knee, as pictured).







- NO JEANS ALLOWED except on Friday. If jeans have rips or tears, they MUST have tights or material underneath to cover any visible skin.
- Undergarments: Undergarments must NOT be visible, neither outside nor underneath clothing. This includes white tank-tees worn under shirts.
- Headwear: No hats, caps, bandanas, skull caps, do-rags, bonnets, scarves, nor any other head covering (unless for religious purposes) may be worn at any time while on campus.
- Hooded Jackets/Sweaters and Hoodies are ALLOWED. However, they must be worn with an appropriate uniform top underneath. For increased safety, the hoods SHALL NOT be worn on the head inside the building including classrooms and they **MUST** follow the same guidelines as Shirt/Tops above.
- Footwear: Tennis shoes and other closed toe shoes are the preferred footwear. House shoes, slides, flipflops, and Crocs are **NOT** approved to be worn in the building at any time.
- Jewelry and Accessories: No illegal/inappropriate jewelry or other accents such as guns or weapons will be allowed. Sunglasses are **NOT** allowed in the building.
- Student ID & Backpacks: Badges MUST be worn at all times throughout the day. Clear and Mesh backpacks ONLY unless the bags are athletic bags for sports (including cheerleading, dance, etc.).
- School Organization Days / Special Dress Days: Students are allowed to wear specific attire on designated days. Students who wish not to participate on the designated Special Dress Days must maintain regular school uniform dress. All other Dress Code guidelines as far as hats, headwear and footwear still apply.
