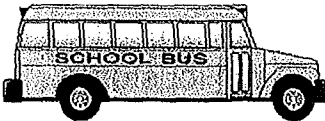


# Memorial Hermann Health Centers for Schools BURBANK CLINIC

## What types of services does the Clinic provide?

## Who do we serve?

We are **FREE** to all students who attend the following schools: Burbank Elementary, Herrera Elementary, Janowski Elementary, Roosevelt Elementary, Burbank Middle School, Sam Houston High School, and Wheatley High School. We bill Medicaid, Amerigroup, and Community Health Choice. We are a primary care provider to uninsured and Medicaid students and a back-up provider for students with insurance.

## What is required?

A parent/guardian's consent, a shot record copy, a list of medications, and a copy of the insurance or Medicaid card.

## What is the Clinic Schedule?

Monday thru Friday from 7:30a.m. to 4:00p.m., and closed daily for lunch from 12:00p.m. to 1:00p.m. We are also open on most school holidays and throughout the summer.

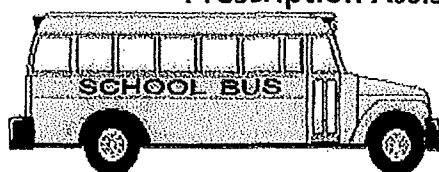

- Prescription Assistance

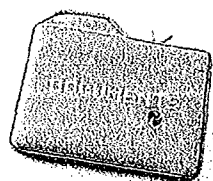

### What is required?

- When applying for SNAP & Medicaid:
  - Social Security numbers for all who are applying
- When applying for a Gold Card:
  - Identification of all adults over the age of 18
  - Birth Certificates for all children
  - Proof of Income
  - Utility Bill
  - If parents are married, but do not have the same last name, a Marriage Certificate will be needed
