Herod Elementary Enrichment Program Policies and Procedures

REGISTRATION FEE \$25.00. Registration is not complete, and classes are not secured until the \$25 registration fee is paid. Payments are accepted at www.schoolpay.com. Cash, checks and money orders are also accepted at the Meet the Teacher events. Checks are payable to Herod Elementary.

REGISTRATION FORM. Registration forms must be on file for all Enrichment participants. Parents may pay for enrichment classes and registration fees online through SchoolPay beginning on August 14, 2019 but must submit the registration form by August 30, 2019. Registration forms must be submitted at the same time as in-person payments made at the Meet the Teacher events.

EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN is available to you as a convenience. We are solely dependent on payment of tuition and fees to meet our expenses. First payment (1/2 of tuition plus supply fees and the registration fee) is due at registration. The remaining balance is due Monday, October 14, 2019. Please make your payments in a timely manner to avoid the \$25.00 late fee charge. Payments are accepted at www.schoolpay.com.

CLASS CANCELLATION. If your child is enrolled in an Enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued.

WITHDRAWAL. A student may be withdrawn from any Enrichment class by providing written notice to the Enrichment Coordinator. A refund will be issued for any classes remaining after the withdrawal date. A refund will not be offered if 5 or fewer classes remain.

NO AFTER-CLASS SUPERVISION. Absolutely no supervision is provided after enrichment classes are dismissed. All children must be picked up and signed out promptly when class is dismissed. You will be charged a late pick-up fee of \$1.00 per minute. After the 3rd late pick-up, your child will be suspended from the program. Parents must sign out their child/children at the front desk.

CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE. In order to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which to teach Enrichment classes, students must exhibit appropriate behavior. Children enrolled in Enrichment classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct. Children who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to Herod administrators and/or suspension from the Enrichment Program. Children suspended from the Enrichment program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.

Beginner's/Advanced Chess (K-5) Instructed by: Mr. Zarwulkoff

Chess has been shown to raise individual's intelligence quotient (IQ) scores, enhance academic performance in reading and mathematics, and strengthen problem solving, critical-thinking, and decision-making skills. Chess improves concentration and memory, develops logical thinking, and promotes creativity.

Art (K-1 & 2-5) Instructed by: Ms. Roberson

Does your child love to create? This class will have them drawing, painting, sculpting, and learning all about art! We'll introduce many types of mediums and teach about art styles and famous artists in this weekly 1-hour class. Maximum: 14 students

Baseball (K-3) Instructed by: Athletes After School

This class will teach your son or daughter the correct fundamentals in the three major aspects of baseball or softball. Throwing, fielding and hitting will be emphasized and students should bring their own gloves. Rules of the game will also be taught during in-class scrimmage games. Class will be held on playground.

Basketball (2-5) Instructed by: Athletes After School

Learn the fundamentals of basketball as students play this exciting sport. Students will focus on the basics of the game, as they learn to dribble under control, shoot and pass. Rules of the game will be taught during in-class scrimmage games. Class will be held in the Multi-Purpose Room with warm-up exercises taking place on outside playground.

Cake Decorating (K-5) Instructed by: Krafty Kreations

In this class young bakers will uncover their skills as they put the icing on their cakes, cupcakes, and other delicious treats. Students will enjoy interacting with peers, while learning how to make and color icing, as well as working with fondant. Young bakers will bring home their treats every week. Calligraphy (3-5) Instructed by: Ms. Baltazar

Are you in awe of beautiful handwriting? Join me as we improve your penmanship and learn classic calligraphy. Students will be taught how to create beautiful lettering using chisel nib calligraphy markers. Maximum: 15 students

Cartooning/Anime (2-5) Instructed by: Ms. Roberson

Students will learn the characteristics of Japanese anime characters with basic drawing and coloring techniques first. We will explore characters such as Mario, Hello Kitty and Pikachu. In this class, we will explore Japanese contemporary drawing styles to create Japanese anime characters of our own vision and design. Maximum: 14 students

Cooking (K-2 & 3-5) Instructed by: Ms. Norman

Your children will stir up a lot of fun with fun themes and activities focused on food, cooking and nutrition. They will learn the basics of cooking and food prep and enjoy a hands-on experience. Maximum (K-2): 10 students Maximum (3-5): 14 students

Craft Girls (1-5)**Instructed by: Ms. Atondo**

Come get crafty with Ms. Atondo! Students in this class will create a variety of different crafts throughout the semester that they will bring home! FYI: Students will use glue guns at certain points throughout the semester. Maximum: 10 students

Do you love dance, shake, wiggle, and twirl? Come learn some new moves with Ms. Flanagan and Ms. Rosenfield! Students will learn dance basics, as well as several routines that will be performed in a recital at the end of the semester.

Dungeons and Dragons (4-5)**Instructed by: Coach**

Dungeons and Dragons offers many opportunities for critical thinking, varied math skills, collaboration, imagination, group strategy, creative problem solving and storytelling. Your adventure awaits on Tuesday afternoons this Spring! Maximum: 6 students.

Fencing (3-5)**Instructed by: Houston Sword Sports**

Fencing is unique, athletic, mentally stimulating, artistic and above all, FUN! Fencing is a lifetime sport that provides participants with both a physical and mental challenge. Students who take this course improve their reaction time as they learn the fundamental moves and commands of fencing. Students will also learn the history behind this sport of knights and swashbucklers. Maximum: 24 students

Flag Football/Conditioning (2-5)**Instructed by: Athletes After School**

Are you ready for some more football? Now your child can learn the basic rules of the game through this non-contact sport. They will enjoy learning stretching techniques and conditioning that can be used in any sport. Class will be held on school playground. Maximum: 20 students.

Gymnastics (PK-2 & 3-5)**Instructed by: Token Tumblers**

Your child will enjoy participating in this exciting class once a week. They work in areas of floor tumbling, balance beam, and mini-trampoline. Three goals are set for each student: to have FUN; to control our bodies both physically and mentally; and to learn to work HARD. Maximum: 25 students per class

Harry Potter Club (3-5)**Instructed by: Ms. Baltazar**

Attention all wizards! Join us as we explore Pottermore and play Hogwarts games.

Intro to 3D Printing (2-5)**Instructed by: Ms. Izfar**

They will focus on physical and mental development.
