Application



All students must apply. Take advantage of the resources and connections you have at your disposal. If you are already a magnet student from another campus or if you are currently in the Attucks STEAM program, be one of the first to apply.

Phase 1 Application



December 14, 2022 - February 2, 2023 Complete the application, submit all documents, apply for transportation if you live more than 2 miles away. There are 50 seats available for 6th grade, 50 seats for 7th grade and 75 seats for 8th grade.

The Seeding Process



Once you have submitted your application, you are seeded/placed in order according to you when your application was submitted even if you are already a STEAM student. First come first serve.

Phase 2 - Being Offered a Seat



April 5 begins phase 2 of the application process. Applicants are notified via email and a letter, sent to the address provided, informing the applicant they are being offered a seat. Parents must accept the seat. The deadline is June 15, 2023.

I MISSED THE DEADLINE



Some campuses may still have "Seats Available" and you may be accepted based on space being available in that particular program. Don't depend on that. Be sure to get your application in early!!

Get organized



Be sure all documents are completed in the enrollment packet. Be sure an Entrance Agreement is signed by the parent and the student.

S.W.A.S.- SCHOOL WITHIN A SCHOOL

Our campus has a SWAS - School Within A School - where magnet students only have classes with their STEAM Magnet peers.

ACCELERATED CURRICULUM

The magnet curriculum is accelerated which allows students the opportunity to take high school credit courses such as Biology, Principles of Information Technology, Principles of Applied Technology, Journalism, Algebra, Geometry, and Introduction to Computer Science.

STEM LABS

We have STEMLabs where 3D printers, robots, and other technology are integrated in the classroom. Attucks robotics teams (Robattucks) host and compete in competitions.

GIFTED AND TALENTED

We use (PLTW) Project Lead The Way curriculum to enrich the experiences of our students who are GT. Core Enrichment such as band, dance, art, and journalism develop/introduce a student's talent.

FREE TRANSPORTATION

Free HISD Transportation is provided for students enrolled in the magnet program who live two or more miles away.

FIELD EXPERIENCES

Magnet field experiences such as NASA, zoo trips, boat trips, college tours, Challenger Park. Students also have access to guest speakers in STEAM careers via guest speakers and virtual activities.

FREE ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Students receive academic support through free intervention classes in Reading and/or Math, after-school tutorial and Saturday tutorial.
