## COVID-19 GUIDANCE & PROTOCOLS FOR CONFIRMED, PRESUMED, AND EXPOSED INDIVIDUALS

Requirements Prior to Return to Work/School	Completion of quarantine time, fever free for at least the past 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, and with improvement of symptoms.	Completion of quarantine time or qualifications for early return, fever free for at least the past 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, and with improvement of symptoms.	Symptom free and completion of quarantine time or qualifications for early return.		
Fully vaccinated individuals: Those with two Pfizer/Moderna or one Johnson & Johnson vaccine	If test positive for COVID-19, you must quarantine under the Confirmed guidelines.	If you display symptoms of a recognized communicable disease, you must quarantine under the presumed guidelines.	If you are exposed to a presumed/confirmed case, there is no need to quarantine if you are symptom free and the exposure happened at least 14 days after your last COVID vaccine date. Individuals must take a COVID-19 test three-to-five days after exposure.
