Students will need to sign up for a specific time slot to pick up their HISD laptop and textbooks either on August 17, 18, or 19. These are the dates designated for 9th grade students. In order to maintain the health and safety of staff and students, only students will be allowed in the building. All students must wear masks and maintain social distancing when in the building. The process is estimated to take 1 hour. Parents may drop off students and return in one hour or parents may wait in the school parking lot.

Within the next several weeks you will receive emails with important information, announcements, and dates that will assist in the transition to DeBakey HSHP. Students and parents will also receive invitations to attend afternoon and evening <u>virtual</u> "Microsoft Teams Meetings".
