Staying Healthy at School- HISD and the Centers for Diseases Control and Prevention (CDC) are continuing to monitor the coronavirus closely. Students and staff are encouraged to follow basic hand and cough hygiene measures to prevent colds, flu, and coronavirus.

The best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed to a virus. CDC recommends everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

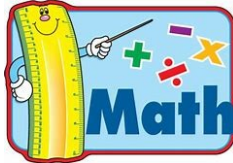
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick and remain home until fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medication.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

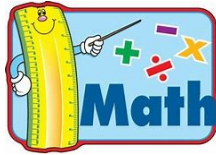
La mejor manera de prevenir infección es de evitar ser expuesto a un virus. CDC recomienda acciones preventivas diarias para ayudar a prevenir la propagación de virus respiratorios, incluyendo:

Lavarse las manos a menudo con jabón y agua por lo menos 20 segundos. Si no hay jabón ni agua, use un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol que contenga al menos 60 por ciento de alcohol.

- Evite tocarse los ojos, nariz y la boca sin lavarse las manos.
- Evite contacto cercano con personas que están enfermas.
- Quedese en casa cuando está enfermo y manténgase en casa hasta que no tenga fiebre por 24 horas sin medicamento para reducir la fiebre.
- Cubra su tos o estornudo con un pañuelo, luego tire el pañuelo a la basura.

Limpie y desinfecte los objetos y superficies tocados con frecuencia.
