

# Attendance

- Students who engage in learning activities via the HUB, participate in a Teams meeting with teachers, or submit assignments via the HUB are considered "present" and will not be marked absent. Students can engage with their teacher though the following: daily participation in the HUB, completion of independent reading and work assignments, use of assigned digital tools, and/or group interactions or interaction with teacher via Teams as part of live or small group instruction.
- Students assignment submission via the HUB for each scheduled class.

- Students who have not logged in by the following times will be marked absent: K-8 schools 3:30p.m. This absence can be resolved if the student engages in daily learning assigned by their teachers via the HUB by 11:59 p.m. that same day.
- If a student is engaged in remote learning and completes the entire weeks' worth of learning activities on Monday and does not log in for the remainder of the week, he/she will be marked "present" on Monday only and counted "absent" for Tuesday-Friday.

# Monitoring Progress

How will the school determine progress for my child?

### Grading during Virtual Instruction

- Teachers will post grades on a weekly basis.
- There are two specific types of grades each week.
- One grade will reflect progress on the Montessori work plan for each area (e.g. completed required works from the work plan that week), and one grade will reflect competency/mastery of grade level TEKS for that area/work.
- Teachers will be recording 2 grades per subject each week, which will be available for parents and students to access through the HISD Connect Parent Portal.

- Teachers will determine which piece of work from the week reflects
   mastery of the TEKS/objectives taught for the week as a grade.
- Our school rubrics will be used in determining weekly grades for
   progress on the Montessori work plan:
