

Walgreens has partnered with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) to open drive-thru testing locations in select areas. Testing is available at no-cost* for people with and without health insurance coverage.

Who is eligible?

Individuals age 18 and older who meet the testing criteria established by the CDC and state and federal guidelines are eligible

How do I get tested?

- Complete a quick screening at Walgreens.com/COVID19Testing
- If eligible, you'll choose a location and time for your testing
- You will receive a follow up email with your appointment confirmation
- Bring a valid ID and insurance card if you have insurance coverage
- The test is at no-cost* to you, even if you don't have insurance

How is the test administered?

- The test is a self-collection test using a nasal swab, while remaining inside your car
- A Walgreens pharmacy team member will be on-site to provide instructions and help you perform the test yourself

How will I get results?

- Tests will be available in approximately 3 to 4 days
- You will receive your results from Walgreens by phone or email, or you can get your results by registering on patient.labcorp.com
