CHILD HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

DAY 1

- The school will contact you to pick up your child
- When you arrive, the School Nurse will meet with you to discuss next steps and answer questions
- Students will be counted as having an excused absent when in quarantine or isolation with a maximum of 20 excused absences
- Monitor your child's symptoms and contact your healthcare provider if you have questions

DAY 6

- Your child has been isolated for **5 days** and can return to in-person school on Day 6 if they have been fever free for a full 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication and their symptoms are improving. If your child continues to have a fever or feel poorly, they should continue to isolate at home
- Your child must report to the school nurse before returning to class



CHILD HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLASSMATE OF A CONFIRMED CASE

DAY 1

- Check in with your child to see if they are experiencing symptoms
- As long as they do not have symptoms, your child does not have to quarantine
- If your child starts experiencing symptoms contact your healthcare provider and get them tested for COVID-19
