### Course Selection - Now through May 21st

Most have already completed course selection via the instructions posted on the <u>Class of 2026 webpage</u>. For those who haven't, a <u>video and instructions can be found here.</u>

#### Remember that you must submit the following documents once available

- FINAL end of year 8<sup>th</sup> grade report card with the word "PROMOTED"
- FINAL 7<sup>th</sup> grade report card
- AP scores (if relevant)
- Other School Records; ARD/IEP, 504 (if applicable)

<u>June 15<sup>th</sup></u> so the counselors can place the students in the appropriate classes.

#### New Student Orientation May 21st

We will have <u>2 sessions available</u>: a morning (7:45am-12pm) and an afternoon (12:45pm-5pm). *This will be a structured event* so please arrive on time. <u>Registration will be REQUIRED via the link here.</u>

#### Bring a copy of the student's most recent 8th grade report card.

Teachers and staff will be on campus to answer any questions and the PTO will also be selling uniforms.

\*The registrar will be distributing an enrollment packet that day that will need to be submitted. The forms can be <u>found here</u> if you would like to complete them ahead of time to help expedite the process.

### Online Enrollment Registration due May 27th – non-HISD students ONLY

Students that are <u>currently **NOT** attending</u> an HISD campus, are <u>REQUIRED to complete online enrollment</u> <u>by May 27th.</u> This will enable that the student is placed in the system correctly and is setup and ready to go for their 9<sup>th</sup> grade year.
