VALEDICTORIAN

In each graduation class, the student with the highest-Grade Point Average (G.P.A) has the honor of being valedictorian. The honor is bestowed upon the student who, through dedication and commitment to academic excellence, has earned the highest grade-point average in his or her class.

A student's G.P.A is determined at the end of the first semester of the senior year by totaling and averaging the semester average of all high school courses that have been taken for credit through seven semesters. Graduating seniors are then ranked by grade-point average to determined class standing.

SALUTATORIAN

The salutatorian is the student who has excelled by earning the second-highest G.P.A in his or her graduating class. The same procedure as that used for class valedictorian determines the salutatorian honor.

EVENT SPONSOR

Smart Financial Cred Union, a full-service financial cooperative, had been serving HISD since 1934 when small group of HISD employees formed the credit union. Their investments and Charter application formed the Houston Public School Teachers Credit Union, now known as Smart Financial Credit. The first credit union office was housed at Sam Houston High School in Room #117.

Since its inception 87 years ago, Smart Financial has been a partner of the district. As a financial cooperative, it has been served the employees of HISD with loans and savings products. As a valued community partner, teachers and students have received resources from the credit union because of the mutually beneficial relationship it literacy for students, a scholarship program for graduating high school seniors, a student-run branch inside Lamar High School, has been a sponsor for the HISD State of the Schools Address.
