SHIRTS/TOPS	1. Polo: HSLJ Polo, or Solid Color Polo 2. T-Shirt: HSLJ Shirt, Solid Color T-Shirt 3. College Polo/T-Shirts allowed any day (No cut-off tops, mid-drift/abdomen must be covered)	 Navy Blue / White / Grey / Black Navy Blue / White / Grey / Black Any color as long as they are representing a college/university
PANTS	Pants: Twill/Khaki/Dickie/Docker style Jeans: Denim jeans (No rips, holes, embellishments, low-rise, rolled up, patches or frayed hems. No leggings, yoga pants or tights of any kind.)	1. Navy Blue / Black / Khaki 2. Blue / Black / White (Jeans must not have rips or tears)
SKIRTS/SHORTS	Knee-length shorts/skirts with no slits, <u>must not</u> <u>be shorter than one inch above the knee while</u> <u>standing.</u> (Leggings may be worn under skirts and must be <u>black or navy</u> .)	Navy blue / Black / Khaki / White
HOODIES/ SWEATSHIRTS/ SWEATERS/ JACKETS	HSLJ Logo/Approved club, or solid color with no visible logo. (Hoods MUST remain off at all times.)	Navy Blue / White / Grey / Black
SHOES	Closed toe and closed heel. NO sandals, crocs or croc style, flip flops, slides or house shoes.	1. Any color
OTHER	 Student ID Badges or a Temporary Student ID Badge must be visible at all times. HEADGEAR: Hair wrapped with scarf allowed – NO caps, hats, bonnets, sunglasses, bandanas, du-rags, etc. Proper hygiene and grooming applicable to all students.
