PANTS	<div>1. Pants: Twill/Khaki/Dickie/Docker style</div> <div>2. Jeans: Denim jeans</div> <div><u>(No rips, holes, embellishments, low-rise, rolled up, patches or frayed hems. No leggings, yoga pants or tights of any kind.)</u></div>	<div>1. Navy Blue / Black / Khaki</div> <div>2. Blue / Black / White</div> <div><i>(Jeans must not have rips or tears)</i></div>
SKIRTS/SHORTS	<div>1. Knee-length shorts/skirts with no slits, <u>must not be shorter than one inch above the knee while standing.</u> (Leggings may be worn under skirts and must be <u>black or navy.</u>)</div>	<div>1. Navy blue / Black / Khaki / White</div>
HOODIES/ SWEATSHIRTS/ SWEATERS/ JACKETS	<div>1. HSLJ Logo/Approved club, or solid color with no visible logo.</div> <div>(Hoods MUST remain off at all times.)</div>	<div>1. Navy Blue / White / Grey / Black</div>
SHOES	<div>1. Closed toe and closed heel.</div> <div>2. NO sandals, crocs or croc style, flip flops, slides or house shoes.</div>	<div>1. Any color</div>
OTHER	<div><div>• Student ID Badges or a Temporary Student ID Badge must be visible at all times.</div><div>• HEADGEAR: Hair wrapped with scarf allowed – NO caps, hats, bonnets, sunglasses, bandanas, du-rags, etc. Proper hygiene and grooming applicable to all students.</div></div>
