Please submit this mandatory pre-registration survey above for the School Day SAT. The survey will close on **Friday, February 26, 2021 at 11:59 pm** and we will not accept any responses/additions after that time or on test day.

The SAT is a standardized test that measures the knowledge and skills in reading, writing, and math that students learn in the classroom—the same knowledge your child needs to succeed in college and career.

Westside High School is offering the opportunity to take a FREE SAT (without essay) to current 11th grade students on Wednesday, March 3, 2021. Tests will be administered on campus as there is no virtual option available at this time.

In order for us to prepare properly and safely, please respond to this survey by Friday, February 26, 2021 at 11:59 pm. If you are a parent, please complete the survey as your student.

Students should arrive at 8:00 am.

Testing will start at approximately 9:00 am and conclude around 1:00 pm; students will be released to return home after all testing materials have been secured.

Please note that this test is not a requirement for graduation.

You should receive an email confirmation once the survey has been completed. Please retain for your records.

Students should bring:

- Mask
- Photo ID/passport (last year's student ID card will suffice as well)
- #2 (non-mechanical) pencils
- Calculator – see <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/taking-the-test/calculator-policy> for College Board's calculator policy and acceptable calculators
  - NOTE: We will have calculators available if a student needs to borrow one, but we encourage students to bring their own

Students should stay home if they are not feeling well, as taking this test is not a graduation requirement
