**Senior Exam Exemptions for Spring Semester**

Students who are classified as **Senior (12<sup>th</sup> grade)** may be exempt from Spring semester final exam from course(s) if they have:

- 85 or better average for the course
- S or E conduct average in that course
  - No level III or IV offenses
- No more than three (3) total absences in that course (excused or unexcused)

**AP Test Final Exam Exemptions for the Spring Semester**

Students taking **AP courses** may be exempt from Spring semester final exam if they meet all the following conditions:

- Must sit for the corresponding AP Exam during the semester
- 85 or better average for the course
- S or E conduct average in that course
  - No level III or IV offenses
- No more than three (3) absences in that course (excused or unexcused)

**The following conditions apply to all exemptions:**

- Students must submit this Acknowledgement form within 2 business days of receiving their qualification notification.
- Any student, who is incorrectly marked as exempt or loses their exemption because of additional absences, will be subject to make up their exams.
- Students who do not make-up exams for which they lost an exemption will receive a zero for their final exam grade.

**Senior Exam Exemptions for Spring Semester**

Seniors are exempt if the following conditions are true:

- Senior classification
- 85 or better average in that course
- S or E conduct average
- No more than three (3) total absences
- Senior has NOT committed a documented cheating or plagiarism incident in that class.
- NO level III or IV offenses; excessive tardies may warrant a Level III offense
- Guidance attendance is included in exemption policy

A student who is awarded an exemption from final is not counted present for ADA funding purposes, even though the student is not required to be in attendance when the exam is given.

**AP Exam to Exempt Students from Final Exam in Spring**

**To reward students, including underclassmen for completing AP Exam(s)**

A student who completes an exam for any AP course may be exempt from the Final Exam for that course if the following is true:

- 85 or better average in that course
- S or E conduct average
- No more than three (3) absences
- Student has NOT committed a documented cheating or plagiarism incident in that class.
- NO level III or IV offenses; excessive tardies may warrant a Level III offense
- Guidance attendance is included in exemption policy

A student who is awarded an exemption from final is not counted present for ADA funding purposes, even though the student is not required to be in attendance when the exam is given.

**A student's exemption may be forfeited at any time, including the day of the final exam.**
