FINAL EXAM EXEMPTION ELIGIBILITY SPRING 2023

- 1) The exemption rules are:
 - a. Seniors (must be coded as a 12th grader in the SIS) will be exempt from <u>ALL classes for</u> which the following criteria are met:
 - i. S2 average of 85 or above as of 5:00 pm on 5/10/23 (Wed)
 - ii. Conduct of S or E
 - iii. No more than 3 absences for the semester (including the day of the final exam)
 - b. **10th & 11th Graders** will be exempt from taking the final exams for <u>TWO (2) academic</u> classes (including any AP courses) in which the student has the highest S2 averages and meets the following criteria:
 - i. S2 average of 85 or above as of 5/10/23 (Wed)
 - ii. Conduct of S or E
 - iii. No more than 3 absences for the semester (including the day of the final exam)
 - iv. If AP course, the student MUST have taken the AP Exam.
 - v. <u>Note</u>: 10th & 11th graders may be exempt from more than 2 final exams <u>ONLY IF</u> <u>ALL of their exemptions are from qualifying AP courses.</u>
 - vi. If a 10th or 11th Grader does not have 2 qualifying academic courses, the student may be exempt from qualifying non-academic courses (such as PE or Band).
 - c. 9th Graders will be exempt from taking the final exam for <u>ONE (1) academic class</u> (including AP course) in which the student has the highest S2 average and meets the following criteria:
 - i. S2 average of 85 or above as of 5/10/23 (Wed)
 - ii. Conduct of S or E
 - iii. No more than 3 absences for the semester (including the day of the final exam)
 - iv. If AP course, the student MUST have taken the AP Exam.
 - v. <u>Note</u>: 9th Graders may be exempt from more than 1 final exam <u>ONLY IF ALL of</u> their exemptions are from qualifying AP courses.
 - vi. If a 9th Grader does not have any qualifying academic course, the student may be exempt from a qualifying non-academic course (such as PE or Band).
