

**DRESS CODE FOR 2023-2024**

**The dress code is a requirement for all students at Barrick Elementary. It is also listed in the Parent/Student Handbook and the school's website.**

Spirit shirts (Barrick t-shirt, college) on Fridays ONLY.	Must be open in the front with buttons or zipper; NO pullovers	No decorations, tears, or rips	Toes cannot be exposed	No extreme hair styles such as unnatural color nor shaved designs
No advertisements	Must fit appropriately	NO blue jeans, leggings, or sweatpants	Socks must be worn	NOT Allowed: makeup, nail polish, fake nails
Shirts must be tucked in	No advertisements	No cargo pants (pants with several pockets)	Laces must be tied *	Caps and head coverings are not allowed inside the building.

**\*PreK students are asked to wear shoes with Velcro straps.**

For Safety Reasons, rolling backpacks are not allowed.

Shorts, jumpers, and skirts: must not be shorter than fingertip length.

The school is not responsible for lost or missing jewelry, smartphones, or other personal items.

Jewelry: chains/necklaces are limited to one small or medium in size.

- Girls- no large hoop earrings (must be smaller than a quarter).
- Boys – no earrings at all.
