The event is a gathering of Houston's top athletes, both past and present, to commemorate, celebrate and recognize Houston's top sports achieve-



As an incentive to participate, students who bring in 5 cans of food during the week of January 27th will be awarded an Altered Dress Day on 02/20/20.


