Grading & Student Expectations for Cycle 6

HISD grading policy:

- Teachers will enter numeric grades into GradeSpeed for assignments submitted, and a zero for unsubmitted grades.
- Final exams have been waived for the spring semester, and academic assignments will be weighted evenly.
- The average of Cycle 6 will be posted on the student report card. If there are no grades, a zero will be posted. After grades have been posted, the system will determine whether Cycle 6 will be calculated with the semester grade.

Are students required to keep working? YES!

Teachers are moving forward with teaching and learning. Assignments are NOT excused.

There ARE consequences of opting out:

- Cognitive regression—forgetting what you learned
- Don't get left behind! 85% of our student body are moving forward and getting ready for next year. Be ready to join them.
- Missed opportunity! Seize the opportunity to enjoy school without pressure of STAAR testing and final exams. Teachers are looking for every opportunity to incentivize students. Do your work!

Seniors, get ready for Senior Check-Out! It is a checklist of sign-offs required for:

- Pick-up of your Cap & Gown
- · Receipt of your Diploma
- Issuance of Final Transcript

Watch for an email this week with specific information regarding outstanding items on your personal check-list. Take care of online items as soon as possible!

You will be assigned a time-slot for the week of May 18th-22nd to come to campus and:

- Return laptops
- Drop off school-owned equipment/ supplies
- Pick-up caps & gowns after you are cleared

(Note: Face masks and social distancing required)

Check-Out List

Library – All books must be returned and outstanding fees paid. (Fees may be paid on SchoolPay.com)

Transcript – (Online) Provide details for a final transcript (free) to be sent to your college/university or military.

College Information – (Online) You must update Naviance, including scholarship proof submitted, and complete the *2020 Senior Exit Survey*.

Power Up – Turn in your laptop and all accessories that were issued to you. Pay fees if owed for missing equipment.

Finances – If you owe equipment or fees to Westside, you will be on hold for final check-out. Watch your HISD email for details about returning athletic equipment/uniforms, art supplies, instruments, etc.

Final Check-Out - This is the last stop! If you have completed or cleared all of the above items, you will receive your cap and gown.

Wolf Band Receives Invite to Elite Festival






