

PSAT on Wednesday for 9th, 10th & 11th Graders

Westside students in Grades 9, 10 and 11 will take the PSAT on Wednesday, October 30th. Students should plan to get a good night's rest, eat a healthy breakfast, and arrive on time for the first bell at 7:35 AM. They must wear their ID around their neck and bring at least one #2 pencil (no mechanical pencils). Students may choose to bring their own calculator, but a calculator is not required to take the test.

Please note, electronic devices are strictly prohibited, including cell phones and smart watches. Devices will



be collected and returned at the end of the test. If it is discovered that a device is not turned in, it will be confiscated for two weeks and disciplinary consequences will apply. The incident will be reported to the College Board, which may result in an unscored test.

Parents, please do not schedule appointments for your students during testing. Students will not be released during testing, and no visitors will be allowed on campus.

Seniors will have a late start on Wednesday and report at 10 AM for Senior Fest.




Inclusive Science Fair






