



Tennis Takes Three Firsts in District


Last week, the Westside Varsity Tennis Team took home three first places from the HISD District Tournament. Lucia and Elisa Rodriguez got 1st in

From HOSA: Drug Take-Back Day on Saturday



Westside HOSA is encouraging the community to participate in the DEA Drug Take Back Day on Saturday, April 24, 2021.

For the past decade, the DEA (or Drug Enforcement Agency) holds two annual events to raise awareness about safe and effective methods to dispose of drugs properly and to avoid accidental death and poisoning to

pets and children. They follow COVID social distancing protocols as well.

The DEA Drug Take Back Day is an easy and non-judgmental way to return drugs, expired medications, legal or illegal drugs and other devices with no questions asked.

Simply ask family members or friends to collect their unused and expired drugs into a plastic bag and drop it off at any of the DEA take back locations. Note: batteries should be removed from Vape pens and devices.

DEA Drug Take Back Day Locations

Locations are throughout the city of Houston, including the local Walgreens and CVS pharmacies. Click the [here](#) to find a convenient location.

Remember, drug addiction and abuse is a mental health condition. While much of society has a stigma associated with drug use, it is important to show compassion and to help educate others about the potential dangers of drug use and abuse.

Disposing drugs safely is the first step in preventing accidental poisoning and death.



Everything we know about Westside's Graduation as of 4/15:

Ticketing and Parking

Tickets are required, and they will be distributed electronically.

Each student will have a set number of tickets for their family. **HISD has not announced how many tickets each student will receive.** When this information is released, it will be shared.

No additional tickets will be made available at the gate entrances.

Parking is free, but parking passes will be required to enter the HISD Sports Complex. Each vehicle will be required to print a parking pass to display on the dashboard.

Venue Rules

No flowers, balloons, banners, signs, noise makers, food or drinks will be allowed into the venue.

Students must arrive dressed in cap and gown (distributed 6/9-6/10 at Senior Check-out – students will be given an appointment by the College Center).

Students will walk across stage to receive their diploma, but no handshakes permitted (elbow bumps are encouraged).

No cell phones or other electronic devices will be allowed on the venue floor by students.

The doors will open for guests at 4pm, and the ceremony begins 5pm. Late arrivals will be seated on the last row to limit distractions.

Students will receive more details about their arrival and other procedures at Westside's graduation practice: 9am on Friday 6/11 in the Commons.



Topic 4: P vs. NP Problem

Math and computer science came together for today's meeting as we discussed another \$1 M problem!

Example: Selection Sort

- Selection Sort sorts a dataset by size order (in this case, we'll do smallest to largest)
- It starts at each element, picks the smallest, and moves that to the front.
- Size of dataset = number of elements in dataset
- For n elements, how many times does the if statement execute?


