

#### Work Day on the Wolf Prairie By Mrs. Klein

Ecology Club and NHS teamed up to work on the Wolf Prairie last week! This enthusiastic crew planted over 120 native prairie plants including Little Bluestem Grasses, Texas Coneflower and Texas Vervain.

In addition to planting, they also dug up Eastern Gamma Grass roots which will be used to propagate new grasses. These native grasses have extremely deep roots and can absorb 8 inches of rain in an hour when mature. These plants will be shared with the Houston Audubon Society and the Houston Parks Department, who will use them in flood mitigation projects all around the city.

Everyone agreed it was great to be outside on a beautiful day and to work together on this important project as Westside Wolves!





## **PSAT for 10th Grade on February 23**

PSAT 10 will be given on Tuesday, February 23, 2021 and is available to all current 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. Pre-registration is required via the survey that may be found here: https:// docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAlpQLScBvG5UcVVXRn6 twT0ThGD0kU22NiWv1yu629oWh-IXbgZCA/viewform?usp=sf link

The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized test that measures the knowledge and skills in reading, writing, and math that students learn in the classroom—the same knowledge and skills your child needs to succeed in college and career.

Westside High School is offering the opportunity to take the PSAT 10 to current 10th grade students on Tuesday, February 23, 2021. All tenth graders may pre-register to take the test, both Face-to-Face Learners and Virtual Students. Tests will be administered on campus as there is no virtual option available at this time.



#### **Mental Health Resources for Students**

- NotOK App: It can be really hard to ask for help, especially in our toughest moments. The NotOK app allows you to
  pre-select up to five contacts, and when you press a button in the app, it will text those contacts with your location
  and a message that says "Hey, I'm not OK. Please call me, text me, or come find me." It's a great way to let your
  support system know that you need some help, even if you can't put it into words.
- National Suicide Prevention Lifeline: The Lifeline provides 24/7, free, and confidential support to people in distress you don't need to be suicidal to reach out. Call 1-800-273-8255 to be connected with a crisis counselor.
- Crisis Text Line: If you prefer texting to talking on the phone, text MHA to 741-741 to be connected with a crisis counselor who will help you get through your big emotions.
- Domestic Violence Hotline: The stressors of COVID have the potential to increase violence between partners and in homes. If you're experiencing domestic violence, looking for resources or information, or are question unhealthy aspects of your relationship, call 1-800-799-7233 or go to their site to virtually chat with an advocate.
