

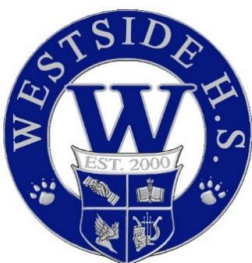



PSAT for 10th Grade on February 23

PSAT 10 will be given on Tuesday, February 23, 2021 and is available to all current 10th grade students. **Pre-registration is required via the survey (deadline to submit survey is Feb. 12):** https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLScBvG5UcVVXRn6_twT0ThGD0kU22NiWv1yu629oWh-IXbgZCA/viewform?usp=sf_link

The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized test that measures the knowledge and skills in reading, writing, and math that students learn in the classroom—the same knowledge and skills your child needs to succeed in college and career.

Westside High School is offering the opportunity to take the PSAT 10 to current 10th grade students on Tuesday, February 23, 2021. All tenth graders may pre-register to take the test, both Face-to-Face Learners and Virtual Students. Tests will be administered on campus as there is no virtual option available at this time.
