

Wolf Prairie News

Last month, Westside shared 60 native prairie plants with Spring Branch HS. The Spring Branch environmental program is installing a new pocket prairie to increase diversity on their campus. Westside's Wolf Prairie has been an instrumental learning lab for students since the campus opened in 2000. It was our pleasure to provide plants to help start a new prairie for an-



other campus.

For many years, Wolf Prairie benefitted from donations of plants and other materials from other schools and organizations. Our prairie is now mature enough to start using seeds to grow new plants for others.

WHS students started the seeds in small pots last spring before the pandemic. The plants were maintained throughout the summer and "bumped up" into gallon pots as their root systems developed. The Black Eyed Susans, Little Bluestem Grasses, Blazing star and Seaside Golden rod plants that were sent to Spring Branch HS are providing a strong foundation for their outdoor classroom.

Testing Updates

PSAT for 10th Grade on February 23

The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized test that measures the knowledge and skills in reading, writing, and math that students learn in the classroom—the same knowledge and skills your child needs to succeed in college and career.

Westside High School is offering the opportunity to take the PSAT 10 to current 10th grade students on Tuesday, February 23, 2021. All tenth graders may pre-register to take the test, both Face-to-Face Learners and Virtual Students. Tests will be administered on campus as there is no virtual option available at this time.

In order for us to prepare properly and safely, please respond to this survey as your student by Friday, February 12, 2021 at 11:59 pm.

Please note that this test is not a requirement for graduation.
