

Teacher Spotlight of the Week Jeff D'Onofrio



HISD's AP U.S. Government Lead Teacher Westside's Senior Class Coordinator

I attended the George Washington University in D.C. for a Bachelor's in Political Science and a Master's in Secondary Education. I love talking to my seniors about their college plans, and I freely admit to a heavy bias towards recommending urban schools. I want students to consider how they'll spend their time outside of class and where they might want to live and work after graduation.

I have taught at Westside since 2016. Prior to that, I was the social studies department chair and a sixth-grade history teacher in Northern Virginia. I began my career teaching third grade in a Washington, D.C. charter school. I always hoped I would be able to teach seniors, but I really enjoyed those younger grades, too. There is absolutely nothing I'd rather be teaching than AP U.S. Government and AP Macroeconomics. I'll do this forever if Westside will let me!

The reason I went into education is because I've always loved working with kids and helping other people. I really enjoy guiding students towards the right answers and opening their eyes to how the world really works. I also want to demonstrate how their math and writing skills matter in social studies as well as in the adult life that awaits them.

I love Westside High School because of our incredible students. I'm continually impressed by how much they successfully juggle: several AP classes, part-time jobs, varsity athletics, volunteer work, and the stress of college applications. I warn them that it can be tempting to take it easy in college, but that I believe they'll find more success in staying busy. I also appreciate the kindness and work ethic that's clearly instilled by their families.

My favorite memories from high school change as I get older and appreciate different things. Today, I most value the times I got out of my comfort zone like becoming a varsity cheerleader, or challenging my stutter by competing in Quiz Bowl competitions.

If I wasn't a teacher at Westside High School, I would love to be a political cartoonist. There are only about 40 editorial cartoonists employed by newspapers today, so I think I have better odds of making it on an NBA roster!







SENIOR DUES

• Senior Dues are **MANDATORY** for all seniors or fourth-year students.

• Every senior is expected to make a one-time payment of **\$70** by Friday, 12/18/20.

• If a student misses that fall deadline, a \$30 late fee will be added. The new one-time payment of **\$100** will be due by the start of Spring Break: Friday, 3/12/21.

• Students do not have the option to select and pay for only individual items from the list below. The total dollar amount is non-negotiable.

What is paid for by Senior Dues?

- 1. Cap and Gown
- 2. Diploma & Diploma Cover
- 3. Awards for Senior Honors Night (medals, cords, and other graduation regalia)
- 4. Graduation Ceremony

Administrative Expenses (COVID-19 preparations, unexpected increases, etc.)

Students who do not pay dues will not receive their cap/gown or a diploma, and they will not be able to attend any graduation ceremonies.

FAQ's - Yearbooks & Portraits - Class of 21

- 1. I have questions about Westside yearbooks & senior portraits, who can answer them?
- a. Contact Ms. Roberts at srobert2@houstonisd.org or if you are on campus come by A216. Email is better than TEAMS messages.
- 2. How do I book my appointment for my Senior Portrait?
- a. Go to the Westside High School portal at: <u>www.seniors.legacystudios.com</u>
- 3. How much does it cost:
- a. The sitting fee is \$10 (payable with a debit or credit card, or PAYPAL), must be paid at the time of booking. Legacy offers packages.
- 4. What if I want extra poses and personal pictures?
- a. Legacy has a studio feature for additional poses and personalized SENIOR SHOWCASES. See info is on our Westside portal.
- 5. Caps? What will that do to my hair? What about my big head?
- a. Great question! You will be wearing a graduation gown, but you will be holding your cap. Style your hair, don't worry about your big head. FYI, your hands will be showing in the photo, so pay some attention to your nails.
- 6. Who typically forgets to take a Senior Portrait?
- a. GUYS! tend to forget about this. Every spring I talk to moms who want to know "what can we do?" So tell the MOMS of GUYS!!!!!
- 7. Can I wear my giant earrings?
- a. We are asking for earrings and pendants no bigger than a quarter.
- 8. What about make-up?
- a. You want the photo to look like you. Don't go crazy, or use make-up you have never used before. Remember, your hands will show. You want them the same color as your face.
- 9. What about COVID?
- a. Legacy has strict guidelines for both your safety and the photographers. You will be required to wear a mask until the time you sit in the chair for your picture. There will be NO mirrors at the photographer's station. Make sure you are ready when you come inside for your appointment.
- b. If you fail to comply with the guidelines, you will be asked to leave, and you sitting fee will be forfeited.
- 10. I made an appointment, but I can't make it?
- a. If there is another day/time available you can rebook. If you just fail to show up, you will forfeit your sitting fee.
- 11. Can my mom, little sister or friend come with me?
- a. No one but you will be allowed inside the Auditorium. We know moms like to attend this monumental occasion, but this year, we have had to say no.
- b. If you need assistance, please let Ms. Roberts know beforehand.
- 12. I don't see my questions answered in this list, what do I do?
- a. Contact Ms. Roberts, she will help you.
