



You will need to create an FSA ID—an electronic signature that you will use to sign the FAFSA documents. You can do this BEFORE October 1st!


- Create one at fsaid.ed.gov

- If parent does not have a SSN, parent will sign manually




The Myths of Attending a Small College

What is paid for by Senior Dues?

- 1. Cap and Gown
- 2. Diploma & Diploma Cover
- 3. Awards for Senior Honors Night (medals, cords, and other graduation regalia)
- 4. Graduation Ceremony

Administrative Expenses (COVID-19 preparations, unexpected increases, etc.)

Students who do not pay dues will not receive their cap/gown or a diploma, and they will not be able to attend any graduation ceremonies.
