

New Superintendent Visits Westside, Attends #RAK Event

HISD's new Superintendent, Millard House II, visited Westside High School on Tuesday to join Wolf Band students in a ceremony honoring their band mate, David Castro, who passed away in July.

Mr. House began his visit by adding a personal post to the #RAKDavid board in the front hallway. "#RAKDavid" (random acts of kindness in David's name) was initiated by his family following his death in a road rage incident. As a counter-point to the tragedy, they asked friends and community to perform random acts of kindness to spread love and positivity.

The superintendent then joined the Per-

cussion Ensemble on the Band Hall lawn for performances and a tree dedication ceremony. David's family attended the event, including his brother, Luke, who follows in his brother's footsteps as a Wolf Band percussionist.

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A Letter from Principal Wittpenn



Greetings Westside Parents,

Welcome to the 2021-22 school year! We are excited to have begun our first week of school with your student. The inperson energy is palpable, and I look forward to a wonderful year of learning and growth. The theme of our professional development last week for welcoming back teachers was "Re-Emerge and G.R.O.W., the acronym standing for Growth, Resilience, and Optimism at Westside. This is a sentiment I want to continue to encourage in our student body as well; we will reunite and persevere despite the obstacles presented to us over the past 18 months.

I wanted to share with you all some updates as it relates to COVID reporting. Last year, any time there was a positive or presumed positive case, I sent out a community wide call-out. This year, the process has been updated, and the most up to date information can be found outlined in the Houston ISD's "Ready, Set, Go!" plan linked here: readysetgo (houstonisd.org). Our nurse investigates and begins the contact tracing process on our campus, and documents all exposed, presumed and confirmed COVID 19 cases. This year, we will only inform parents of a COVID case if their student came into direct contact with someone on campus that was presumed positive or confirmed positive. If you would like information regarding active COVID cases, you may access that information on the Houston ISD COVID Dashboard site here: Special Sections/COVID-19 Dashboard (houstonisd.org).

Additionally, our quarantining protocols have been updated to distinguish between vaccinated and unvaccinated persons. If your student is vaccinated, we encourage you to provide a copy of their vaccination record to the nurse at Downelle.Campbell@houstonisd.org. We also encourage that if your student is tested, that the test results are shared with our nurse at the previously mentioned email; please refrain from bringing the results to campus, as visitors to our campus remain limited at this time. Below is the protocol regarding quarantine:

Unvaccinated Individuals:

Exposed to a Confirmed Positive or Presumed COVID-19 Case (Close Contact): Quarantine for 10 days after the last exposure date to the Confirmed COVID-19 Positive or Presumed COVID-19 Case. Return to campus on day 11.

Vaccinated Individuals:

Fully vaccinated individuals are those who have received one dose of Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine or the second dose of Pfizer/Moderna COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before exposure to a presumed or confirmed COVID-19 case. Fully vaccinated individuals exposed to a presumed or confirmed positive case, do not need to quarantine if not having any symptoms. Fully vaccinated individuals should test 3 – 5 days after exposure, even if not having any symptoms. Wear a mask/face covering when indoors in public for either 14 days from exposure or until a negative COVID-19 test result is obtained within 3 – 5 days from exposure. Proof of COVID-19 immunization needs to be provided to determine immunity.

If your student is required to quarantine, they are eligible for Temporary Online Learning (TOL) for a maximum of 10 days (limited to two quarantines for the year). The website to sign up for TOL is linked here: HISD @ H.O.M.E./Temporary Online Learning (houstonisd.org). While this platform is not taught by Westside teachers, our teachers will work with your student to catch up on missed assignments upon their return.

I will be hosting a live event on September 9th and invite you to participate to learn additional information and ask questions.

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Uniform Policy Updated for 2021-2022

Westside Uniform Policy for 2021-2022



Tops

- ✓ T-shirts, polos, sweatshirts and jackets purchased at the School Store
- ✓ Official Westside club and organization shirts and jackets made available to players/members.
- ✓ Official Westside club and organization shirts and jackets sold school-wide as registered fundraisers

Bottoms

- ✓ Jeans, khaki, navy, and black bottoms including pants, shorts, skirts/skorts, and joggers purchased from any retailer of your choice.
- ✓ Fit and style should be school-appropriate and fabrics of solid color with minimal logos/sports stripes etc. Sagging and immodest rips/tears are not permitted. Pajamas are not permitted.

Outerwear

In addition to sweatshirts and jackets purchased from the school store or offered by an official school organization, students may wear navy, royal, black, grey or white sweatshirts and jackets purchased from a retailer of choice. Offensive graphics are not permitted.

Headwear

Permitted—Religious headwear and headbands equal to or less than 1-inch width

Prohibited—All other head wear including hoods, hats, caps, wraps, scarves, visors, durags, wave caps, skull caps, etc.

Accessories

Jewelry, footwear, socks, backpacks and bags, etc. must not display offensive language, images, or symbols. House shoes/slippers are not permitted.

School IDs

Students must wear school IDs at all times during school hours.

Administrative Discretion: Deans and other school administrators have discretion to make final call on mode-of-dress questions, such as conforming to the expected standard or other issues related to taste, fit, level of modesty, etc.






