


Rodeo Art: Best of Show Winner



Covid Testing on Thursdays

Free Covid-19 Testing is available at Westside High School on Thursdays:

School Day SAT

The SAT is a standardized test that measures the knowledge and skills in reading, writing, and math that students learn in the classroom—the same knowledge your student needs to succeed in college and career.

Westside is offering the opportunity to take a FREE SAT to current 11th grade students on Wednesday, March 2, 2022.

Students will be notified of their specific testing location via HISD email and their deans; we will also post a list on the HUB for student reference prior to test day.

Students should arrive by 7:30 am and bring the following:

- Photo ID
- 2 #2 pencils (non-mechanical)
- Calculator (if you have one that you are accustomed to using; we will have some on-hand as well)

Students should be prepared to leave purses/bags/backpacks in the front of their testing location. They should also be prepared to turn in all electronic devices; storing electronics in a backpack or purse is not permitted. College Board policy states that we have to collect them, and test scores can be invalidated if a student is found to be in possession of any electronic devices once the test has begun.

Testing will start at approximately 8:00 am and conclude around 1:00 pm.

There will be no off campus lunch for testers on this day.

Two Wrestlers on State Podium

Westside Wrestling adds TWO All State Wrestlers to our wall of honor.

113 pound **Junior Juan Cantu** placed 4th in the STATE this past weekend to make the ALL STATE podium. This is the second consecutive year Cantu has been All State, placing 5th as a sophomore last year.

138 pound **Sophomore Kyle Lew** Placed 5th In just two years at Westside, Lew has accumulated a 70-8 Record, is a two-time State qualifier, and an All State Wrestler.

This marks the 10th consecutive year that Westside Wrestling has had at least one ALL STATE wrestler and the 5th time in the last decade Westside Wrestling has had two or more All State Wrestlers.

Senior Captain Freddie Pagan made it to the round of 8 but was one match short of placing at State. Pagan Placed 6th at State as a Junior.

Freshman 106 pounder Santi Ramirez became only the 3rd Freshman ever to qualify for the State tournament.

He was also the First Freshman to make the regional finals AND to win a match at the State Tournament


Fardin Mustassim placed 2nd in individual research paper with "Why Did the Ottomans Ally with Germany and Austria-Hungry in WWII?"
