Exploring the "G" in WEGA With Houston Geological Society By Ms. Morris

WEGA is the engineering pathway's special honors academy that focuses on bringing enrichment activities to the students each year in the form of field trips, college talks, special lectures, and paid summer externships. What many people do not realize is the "G" in WEGA stands for Geosciences (Westside Engineering and Geosciences Academy).

Thanks to our friends at the Houston Geological Society, we were able to bring their educational programs to Westside. We had a team of geologists lead by Letha Slagle, a former WEGA parent herself, and Steve Johansen, come to Westside and bring two of their educational programs-Rocks and Minerals and Bones in Schools.

Rocks and Minerals Lab was open to 11th and 12th grade WEGAns as well as some students from Mrs. Klein's AP Environmental Science classes. Students were able to learn about the Rock Cycle, three different types of rocks, how they form, and what their structures told about their depositional environments. Students got to observe incredible rock and mineral specimen samples up close using the use of a hand lens. They learned about the minerals' physical characteristics and internal chemistry, and what type of conditions would need to be present to form the minerals.











Exploring the "G" in WEGA With Houston Geological Society By Ms. Morris

The Bones in Schools program was offered to 9th and 10th grade WEGAns as well as AP Biology classes. Ken Thies, a renowned paleontologist, talked to students about Pleistocene epoch, a time when mammoths, mastodons, giant sloths, and saber-toothed tigers ruled the North American landscape. Students learned about the fauna and flora of the last Ice Age, and got to explore and hold different bones and fossils discovered locally in Southeast Texas.

WEGAns had a fun time exploring the geosciences from the experts. We want to give a special thanks to the Houston Geological Society for volunteering their time to come educate our young scientists and engineers. Thank you to Letha Slagle, Steve Johansen, Ken Thies, and Maime Witt as well as IPAA and Sarah Hewitt for making this possible.


Season Finale for Football

Class or 2022 Senior Dues Information

WHAT'S THE BIG IDEA?

Senior dues are a mandatory, one-time payment that finance senior activities and graduation necessities; components covered by fees are a package and can not be itemized.

WHAT DOES IT COVER?

- Cap & Gown
- Graduation Ceremony
- Diploma & Diploma Cover
- Graduation Panoramic Picture
- Senior Picnic
- Senior T-Shirt
- Senior Awards/Honors Night
- Senior Movie Night

HOW MUCH ARE SENIOR DUES?

- \$140.00 if paid by November 19, 2021 (\$100 if a student receives free or reduced lunch).
- Senior Dues increase to \$180.00 if paid after November 19th. There is no discount for students who receive free or reduced lunch after November 19th. The deadline for all late payments is March 11, 2022.

To receive the discounted price, students <u>MUST</u> complete the Socioeconomic Information Form and be approved:

- Completed from the first day packet and returned to Ms. Mayfield in N207.
- Completed online through PowerSchool, under forms in the left side menu.
- All payments can be made on school pay.
- If credit card payment is not an option, CASH payment can be made through Ms.
 Lockard in the Westside Library

THE FINE PRINT

Seniors who have not paid their dues will lose privileges such as off-campus lunch. Senior Dues will be added to the price of prom tickets if not paid beforehand. Graduation requires mandatory school purchases; therefore, senior dues are not optional.




