Attention Juniors & Junior Parents!

Junior Students and Parents,

This week, Algebra 2 students will take the Math portion of a test called the Texas Success Initiative (TSI). The TSI is a test of college readiness and there are 2 sections—math and ELA. You are only taking one section, math. A passing score is required before a student is allowed to take a college level math class. Why are you taking a college prep test now, you may ask? Great question! The TSI math portion is heavily geared toward the Algebra 2 curriculum, meaning the concepts you have been working on are what is tested! You are in the best position possible to take and pass this test now!

You will be asked to create an account at Accuplacer.org and register yourself with a new account using your HISD email and to take a short pre-assessment before taking the actual TSI. Once you take the actual test, you will have access to your scores through email.

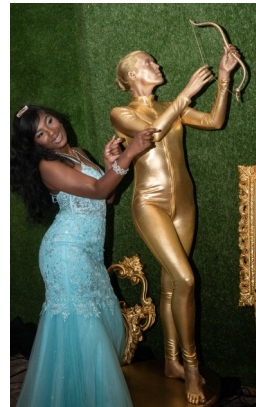
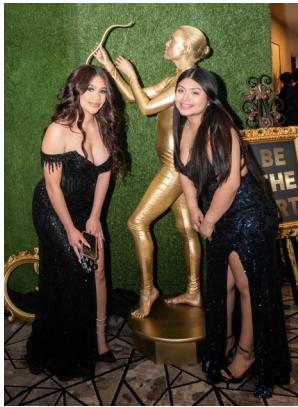
