(In accordance with Texas Education Code Section 25.092 Attendance for Credit 90% Rule; A student at any grade level from kindergarten through grade 12 shall not be given credit or final grade for a class unless the student is in attendance 90 percent of the days in which the class is offered.)

Regular attendance is encouraged to achieve maximum academic success and to establish good habits for college and career. Take a few minutes to chat with your students about the importance of coming to school every day and being on time for all of their classes.

If a student does not have a school laptop or has one that is damaged, they should contact their dean now so that we can address and correct the issue prior to test day.


## Why Take the TSIA2?

## TSIA2 Testing

The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2) is a series of tests for students enrolling in public colleges and universities in Texas. The tests help Texas schools determine whether a student is ready for college-level courses in the areas of reading, writing, and math.

Not all Texas college students have to take TSIA2. If your student has met college readiness standards on a standardized test like the SAT, they may be <a href="exempt">exempt</a>. NOTE: SAT Scores are available in your student's <a href="College Board">College Board</a> account.

If your student is NOT exempt, they can sign up here. The sign up is for notification only, not the test date. Test dates will be available throughout the semester; please see your dean for details.
