WESTSIDE HIGH SCHOOL 23/24 Cell Phone Policy

From 7:45 AM to 3:25 PM, students are required to stow away their cell phones, earbuds and headphones.

- · Students may use their devices during the lunch period only.
- This rule applies throughout the entire school premises.

1st Offense

A warning will be issued to the student, emphasizing the importance of adhering to the policy.

2nd Offense

- The student must surrender the device to the teacher.
- The device will then be submitted to the House Secretary and will be returned at the end of the day.
- For incidents in the hallways, students will be directed to take their devices to the House Secretary for safekeeping until the end of the day.

Note: Refusal to surrender the device will result in further disciplinary actions.

3rd Offense

Parents are required to meet with the dean to discuss repeated violations, and to pick up phone.
The meeting allows for a collaborative effort between parents and school staff to address any underlying issue:

- In cases of repeated violations beyond the second incident, the device may be barred from the campus for the remainder of the school year or until the dean deems it appropriate. This measure is taken to ensure a sustained focus on academic engagement.
- We believe that by implementing these measures, we can create an environment that minimizes distractions, promotes active participation in class, and fosters a more focused learning atmosphere.
- This policy is non-negotiable.





College Center Announcements

Financial aid:

FAFSA - While FAFSA traditionally becomes available every October, due to major changes to the application and website, the 2024-2025 FAFSA application will not be made available <u>until December 2023</u>. An official release date has not been confirmed but colleges across the U.S. are aware of this change. However, the College Center is recommending students to still submit by the original priority deadline of January 15th to be safe. A major change to keep out for is that what was previously known as the "Student Aid Report" will now be shown as "FAFSA Submission Summary."

TASFA – The biggest update to share about <u>TASFA</u> this year is that it will now available online! Each student and one parent/guardian will create an account and complete the application online and will have the ability to send their completed online TASFA applications to up 10 schools.

Scholarships:

HISD has provides students with a list of "Hot Scholarships" that are available to them throughout their senior year. The Hot Scholarship list for October-December is accessible through each student Schoolinks account and be found the by following these steps: Digital Resources > Schoolinks > Finances > Scholarship Matching

Testing:

SAT for <u>Seniors</u> - There are still several opportunities for seniors to take the SAT and/or ACT this school year! While many schools remain test optional, meaning SAT test scores are not required to be sent as part of the admissions process, a school may still ask for a student's test scores to determine that they are "college ready." To meet this criterion, a student must have scored the following: Evidence-based Reading & Writing: 480 and Math: 530

SAT for <u>Juniors</u> - A major change to the SAT is that starting in March 2024, *all* SAT exams given will be *digital*. Click <u>here</u> to find upcoming test dates for the 2023-2024 academic year. Juniors will take the School Day SAT in March 2024, and are recommended not to test before then as they will not have covered some material yet.

ACT – Click <u>here</u> to find upcoming test dates for the 2023-2024 academic year.

College and Career Planning:

- College Center Advisors are currently presenting in all Senior English 4 classes to discuss all things related to the college application process and Schoolinks account setup/utilization.
- Open lab in in the college center is as follows:
 - During lunch
 - ♦ Off campus (7th period)
 - After school (on occasions if we're in a classroom presentation throughout the day)
 - On very few occasions, the college center will be closed due to presentations or trainings.



NEED TO SEND AN OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT?

STEP 1:

- Setup your Schoolinks account (Digital Resources --> Search "Schoolinks")
- Add the colleges you will be applying to under "Final List" AND "College Applications"
- Waive your FERPA rights on Schoolinks AND CommonApp (if applicable)

STEP 2:

- Fill out the yellow "Transcript Request Form" in A205
- Pay \$1-\$2 per transcript you are sending. Allow up t <u>3</u> business days for the request to be completed.


